SUMMARY – An ordinance to amend Title 2, Chapter 2.15 of the Clark County Code to abolish the Office of Constable for the Searchlight Township; and providing for other matters properly relating thereto.

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND TITLE 2, CHAPTER 2.15 OF THE CLARK COUNTY CODE TO ABOLISH THE OFFICE OF CONSTABLE FOR THE SEARCHLIGHT TOWNSHIP; AND PROVIDING FOR OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO.

THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISISONERS OF THE COUNTY OF CLARK, STATE OF NEVADA, DOES HEREBY ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Title 2, Chapter 2.15 of the Clark County Code is hereby amended by adding a new subsection to Section 2.15.10 as follows:

2.15.10 – Abolition of office.

- (a) Pursuant to the provisions of Nevada Revised Statutes 258.010, the board of county commissioners in a county whose population is seven hundred thousand or more, may abolish the office of constable in one or more townships within the county if the board determines that the office is no longer necessary in that township or townships.
- (b) The board of county commissioners, having made a finding that the duties and functions of the office of the constable for the Las Vegas Township can be performed by the office of Sheriff Civil, or through other private or public means, hereby finds it is not necessary to maintain the office of constable for the Las Vegas Township and abolishes said office upon the completion of the term of office of the current officer holder at 11:59 p.m. January 4, 2015.

(c) The board of county commissioners, having made a finding that the duties and functions of the office of the constable for the Searchlight Township can be performed by the office of Sheriff Civil, or through other private or public means, hereby finds it is not necessary to maintain the office of constable for the Searchlight Township and abolishes said office effective [_____].

SECTION 2. If any section of this ordinance or portion thereof is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such holding shall not invalidate the remaining parts of this ordinance.

SECTION 3. All ordinances, parts of ordinances, chapters, sections, subsections, clauses, phrases, or sentences contained in the Clark County Code in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and the publication thereof by title only, together with the names of the County Commissioners voting for or against its passage, in a newspaper published in and having a general circulation in Clark County, Nevada, at least once a week for a period of two (2) weeks.
