Additional Comments:	Initial interlocal agreement amount was \$4,443,953.00. Amendment No. 1 increase of \$1,962,268.99 revises the total agreement amount to \$6,406,221.99, which is to be paid by the Clark County Water Reclamation District to Clark County for constructing sewer improvements as part of the County's project.		

BACKGROUND:

On April 21, 2020, the Board of County Commissioners (also sitting as the Clark County Water Reclamation District Board of Trustees) approved an interlocal agreement between Clark County and the Clark County Water Reclamation District ("CCWRD") to construct the CCWRD's project known as "Project No. 18101A, Collection System Capacity Upgrade - Package 2" as part of the County's roadway resurfacing project known as "Jones Boulevard between Blue Diamond Road and Windmill Lane" (Project No. R033QFT).

With CCWRD's project requiring updates on its construction cost estimate, both the County and CCWRD desire to amend the original interlocal agreement and increase the funding amount up to \$6,406,221.99 ("NOT-TO-EXCEED AMOUNT") to be paid by the CCWRD for the County to construct the sewer facilities with its aforementioned Jones Boulevard between Blue Diamond Road and Windmill Lane roadway resurfacing project.

The attached Amendment No. 1 to the interlocal agreement further details the updates on terms as they relate to the County and CCWRD.

The County District Attorney's Office and the CCWRD's legal counsels have reviewed and approved the first amendment to the interlocal agreement as to form.
