(TabordaENS), and Zee-for LLC for RFQ No. 607056-24 for Hardware and Software Services; and authorize the Chief Financial Officer or designee to sign the Contracts; or take other action as appropriate. Summary:

On August 26, 2024, Request for Qualification (RFQ) No. 607056-24 was advertised on the Clark County Purchasing website and in the Las Vegas Review Journal. Proposals were requested for Hardware and Software Services.

Submittals were received from the following firms: See Submittal Summary attached.

An Ad-Hoc Committee comprised of 7 subject matter experts from the Information Technology Department and an outside expert reviewed and evaluated the submittals. After the evaluation, the AD-Hoc Committee ranked the firms in the order listed in the Submittal Summary attached.
