RESOLUTION FOR DONATION OF MOTOROLA RADIOS

WHEREAS, NRS Chapter 244.1505, authorizes the Board of County Commissioners, or its authorized representative, to donate commodities, supplies, materials, and equipment that are determined to have reached the end of their useful lives; and

WHEREAS, NRS Chapter 244.1505 authorizes donations to nonprofit organizations created for religious, charitable, or educational purposes or to other governmental entities, to be used for any purpose which shall provide a substantial benefit to the inhabitants of the county; and

WHEREAS, the Clark County Fire Department has identified 30 Motorola Radios as surplus property, having reached the end of their useful life; and

WHEREAS, the Silver Run Ski Team, a premier ski team in South Central Montana comprised of approximately 140 athletes, has expressed an interest in receiving the Motorola Radios to enhance safety measures for its operations;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of County Commissioners authorizes the Clark County Fire Department to declare 30 Motorola Radios as surplus property, and to donate said radios to the Silver Run Ski Team's operations, under the following conditions:

- 1. The Motorola Radios have reached the end of their useful life and are officially documented as surplus property.
- 2. The Motorola Radios will be donated for the purpose of enhancing safety measures for the Silver Run Ski Team's operations, which will benefit the inhabitants of the County.
- 3. An Agreement of Transfer of Property is executed between the County and the recipient.
- 4. Any conditions or other limitations on the use of the donated radios will be passed on to the recipient.
