

RESOLUTION FOR ESTABLISHMENT AND USE OF THE IMPACTED PERSON DATABASE

WHEREAS, NRS 244 was amended in the 83rd Session of the Nevada Legislature by Assembly Bill 50, effective October 1, 2025, authorizing the Board of County Commissioners, or its authorized representative, to establish and maintain an electronic database containing information concerning victims of mass casualty incidents to coordinate identification and reunification services, as well as appropriate follow-up and long-term recovery services; and

WHEREAS, the Clark County Fire Department Office of Emergency Management & Homeland Security in partnership with Clark County Information Technology, has collaborated with the Clark County Coroner & Medical Examiner, Clark County Social Services, Southern Nevada Health District, Las Vegas Metropolitan Police Department Missing Persons Unit, and the designated statewide victim assistance center to develop a permission based, HIPAA-compliant database; and

WHEREAS, AB50 requires that such a database comply with HIPAA (45 CFR Parts 160, 162, and 164), NRS 603A, and other applicable privacy and security laws, and further requires that all personally identifiable victim information be deleted after reunification unless written authorization is provided for continued retention for long-term support services; and

WHEREAS, AB50 provides that a county and its officers, employees, and agents are immune from civil liability for any act or omission related to the establishment or maintenance of the database not amounting to willful misconduct, gross negligence, or bad faith; and

WHEREAS, the Clark County Fire Department Office of Emergency Management & Homeland Security in cooperation with the aforementioned agencies, will continue to lead the ongoing multi-jurisdictional effort and provide program management for the deployment and use of the database during declared mass casualty incidents, and for coordination with the statewide victim assistance center for long-term recovery services.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Clark County, Nevada that:

1. The Board hereby establishes and formally recognizes the Mass Casualty Impacted Persons Database as the County's official AB50 electronic database for victims of mass casualty incidents.
2. The Clark County Fire Department Office of Emergency Management & Homeland Security is authorized and directed to develop, maintain, and manage the database in compliance with AB50 and all applicable federal and state privacy and security requirements.
3. The establishment of this database triggers the reporting requirements under AB50 for hospitals and independent emergency medical centers located in Clark County to submit information concerning victims of mass casualty incidents in accordance with state law.
4. The Clark County Fire Department Office of Emergency Management & Homeland Security is further authorized to coordinate with participating agencies, execute operational arrangements as needed, and ensure compliance with confidentiality, retention, and deletion requirements established by AB50.
