

**SUPPLEMENTAL NO. 3 TO THE
PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERING SERVICES CONTRACT FOR
JIM MCGAUGHEY DETENTION BASIN, COLLECTION BASIN AND OUTFALL
(FORMERLY KNOWN AS OWENS DETENTION BASIN AND OUTFALL)**

THIS Supplemental No. 3 Contract made and entered into this 7th day of May, 2024, between CLARK COUNTY, NEVADA, a political subdivision of the State of Nevada, hereinafter referred to as “COUNTY”, and CH2M HILL ENGINEERS, INC., a Delaware corporation authorized to do business under the laws of the State of Nevada, hereinafter referred to as “ENGINEER”. The COUNTY and ENGINEER may herein be referred individually as “Party” or collectively as “Parties”.

The initial addresses of the Parties, which one Party may change by giving notice to the respective other Party, are as follows:

W I T N E S S E T H

WHEREAS, on November 20, 2018, the COUNTY and the ENGINEER entered into a contract for preliminary improvements design, including a recommended alternative for the Owens Detention Basin and Outfall; and,

WHEREAS, on February 5, 2019, the COUNTY formally changed the name from Owens Detention Basin, Collection and Outfall to the Jim McGaughey Detention Basin, Collection and Outfall; and,

WHEREAS, on September 3, 2019, the COUNTY and the ENGINEER entered into a Supplemental No. 1 contract for final design engineering services; and,

WHEREAS, on October 18, 2022, the COUNTY and the ENGINEER entered into a Supplemental No. 2 contract for additional design engineering services; and,

WHEREAS, the COUNTY has previously authorized Special Services for additional slope stability analysis, structural design, legal descriptions, outfall alignment alternatives, redesign of inlet facilities to accommodate adjacent developments, project sign alternatives, additional Dam Safety coordination, and post design services; and,

WHEREAS, the COUNTY desires the ENGINEER to perform additional design engineering services, for the design and coordination with adjacent development, to address additional CCRFCD/NDEP/CCAQ requirements, additional design and coordination with Monroe Avenue property owner, additional survey and legal descriptions, additional structural design, and additional geotechnical investigation; and

WHEREAS, this Supplemental No. 3 contract increase of \$307,065.00 for Basic Services and \$50,000.00 for Special Services and revises the total contract value to \$1,841,219.32.

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the premises and mutual covenants herein contained, it is agreed to supplement the professional engineering services contract dated November 20, 2018, Supplemental No. 1 dated September 3, 2019, and Supplemental No. 2 dated October 18, 2022, as follows:

ARTICLE I: DEFINITIONS

Add the following paragraph to the definition of “Direct Salary” this Section:

The ranges of base rate of pay to be used by the ENGINEER under this Contract for the services authorized on or after June 1, 2024, are those specified in Exhibit “AAAA” attached hereto and made a part hereof by this reference.

ARTICLE II: SCOPE OF SERVICES

2.02 Basic Engineering Services

Add the following to the end of this Section:

GG. Los Feliz Street Maintenance Road and Culvert Crossing Access Design: ENGINEER will provide additional design, coordination, and prepare plans for the Los Feliz culvert crossings to accommodate the planned development on the east side of Los Feliz Street. The task shall include storm drain plan and profile, maintenance and access road horizontal alignments, reconfiguration of the Jim McGaughey Detention Basin inlets, additional hydraulic analysis, cost estimates, and site visits. The ENGINEER shall assist the COUNTY with property owner coordination.

HH. Additional Design for Final Stabilization, 16” Waterline Relocation, Outlet Structure, Maintenance Access, Monument Sign Location: ENGINEER will provide additional design, coordination, prepare plans and special provisions for the additional design requested after the Pre-Final submittal, including additional analysis of the detention basin water quality feature, additional design of the detention basin low-level outlet structure, reconfiguration of maintenance access within the detention basin, NDEP/CCAQ final stabilization requirements, and additional design of 16” waterline relocation. The ENGINEER shall assist the COUNTY with coordination and the design shall consider the CCRFCD/NDEP/CCAQ requirements based on coordination.

II. Monroe Avenue Improvements and Additional Property Owner Coordination:

ENGINEER will provide additional design, coordination, and prepare plans and special provisions to accommodate the new property owner improvements on the south side of Monroe Avenue along APN# 140-26-202-002. The additional design shall include reconfiguration of the improvements along the property including the roadway section, additional driveway, relocation of streetlight, and accommodation for a future block wall. The ENGINEER shall assist the COUNTY with property owner coordination, including field meetings, and the design shall consider the property owner's proposed improvements. ENGINEER shall provide additional utility coordination for relocation of NVE-D transformer necessary for the construction of the improvements.

JJ. Additional Survey and Right of Way Engineering: ENGINEER will, by subconsultant or otherwise, provide additional survey to reestablish horizontal control, survey improvements constructed along Monroe Avenue including grading for future block wall and utility relocations, and for the design of improvements along APN# 140-26-202-002, which has been also improved by the new owner of the property. ENGINEER will provide additional right-of-way engineering including Legal Descriptions and Exhibits necessary for the construction of the storm drain in Los Feliz Street.

KK. Structural Design of RCB and Headwalls along Los Feliz Street: ENGINEER will, by subconsultant or otherwise, provide additional structural design for RCB crossings and headwalls to accommodate developer improvements and the future development on Los Feliz Street.

LL. Structural Design for Access Control and Water Quality Improvements: ENGINEER will, by subconsultant or otherwise, provide additional structural design, alternatives and modifications for the outlet structure, water quality improvements, additional trash racks and grates for access control.

MM. Geotechnical Report Update and Recertification: ENGINEER will, by subconsultant or otherwise, provide an updated geotechnical report to verify that field conditions have not changed.

ARTICLE IV: TIME OF PERFORMANCE

4.01 Time of Performance

Replace the paragraph at the end of 4.01 Time of Performance with the following:

The ENGINEER shall complete all Basic Services and authorized Special Services within completion times as set forth above and by the end of **December 31, 2025**, unless the COUNTY amends such date.

ARTICLE V: PAYMENT FOR SERVICES

5.01 Maximum Amount Payable

Delete the first paragraph in this Section and replace with the following:

The maximum amount payable by the COUNTY to the ENGINEER shall be a sum of money equal to the Basic Services fees plus the Special Services fees, if, as, and when approved by the Director, and provided, however, that under no circumstances may the total amount payable to the ENGINEER under this Contract or in connection with the subject matter of this Contract, exceed the sum of One Million Six Hundred Five Thousand Five Hundred Ninety-Two and 94/100 Dollars (\$1,605,592.94) for the Basic Services fees, and Two Hundred Thirty-Five Thousand Six Hundred Twenty-Six and 38/100 Dollars (\$235,626.38) for Special Services fees, unless such sum is increased by the Clark County Board of Commissioners, but only to the extent such total sum is increased.

5.02 Basic Services and Special Services Fees

Delete the last paragraph in this Section and replace with the following:

In no event may the fees exceed the following Basic Services and the Special Services fees shown below in purposes or amounts:
