SUPPLEMENTAL NO. 1 TO THE PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERING SERVICES CONTRACT FOR TOMPKINS AVENUE FROM KOVAL LANE TO UNIVERSITY CENTER DRIVE

THIS Supplemental No. 1 is made and entered into this the day of obey, 2025, between CLARK COUNTY, NEVADA, a political subdivision of the State of Nevada, hereinafter referred to as COUNTY, and GCW, INC., a corporation authorized to do business under the laws of the State of Nevada, hereinafter referred to as ENGINEER. The COUNTY and the ENGINEER may herein be referred to individually as "Party" or collectively as "Parties."

WITNESSETH

WHEREAS, on August 20, 2024, the COUNTY and the ENGINEER entered into a Professional Engineering Services Contract ("Contract") to design roadway improvements on Tompkins Avenue from Koval Lane to University Center Drive;

WHEREAS, this Supplemental No. 1 to the Contract ("Supplemental No. 1") includes the additional design services to incorporate a detached sidewalk on the south side of Tompkins Avenue and the design of roadway improvements on Koval Lane from north of Tropicana Avenue to north of Harmon Avenue; and

WHEREAS, this Supplemental No. 1 increases funding by \$627,000.00 bringing the total Contract amount to \$1,877,000.00.

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the premises and mutual covenants herein contained, the Parties mutually agree to supplement the Contract as follows:

ARTICLE I: DEFINITIONS

Add the following to the definition of the Project:

The roadway improvements for Koval Lane from 300 feet north of Tropicana Avenue to 500 feet north of Harmon Avenue including the following:

- a. Three northbound travel lanes.
- b. Two southbound travel lanes.
- c. Dual northbound and southbound left-turn lanes at Koval Lane/Harmon Avenue intersection.
- d. Incorporate the design for the proposed improvements of the Harmon Avenue project designed by Clark County.

The design plans, special provisions and cost estimate for the above mentioned improvements will be incorporated with the Contract documents for the Tompkins Avenue from Koval Lane to University Center Drive. Such improvements are to include, at a minimum, hot mix asphaltic concrete, storm drain facilities, curb and gutter, sidewalk, raised median, traffic signal modifications, utility modifications and relocations, NVE conduit and pull boxes for underground of the existing overhead distribution lines, traffic control devices, pavement markings, signage,

horizontal and vertical transitions, and other necessary appurtenances required to make a good, complete, and serviceable Project.

ARTICLE II: SCOPE OF SERVICES

Add the following to Section 2.02:

- V. Revise and update the 90% Plans, Special Provisions, and Cost Estimate to provide a detached sidewalk along the south side of Tompkins Avenue.
- W. Prepare Final Plans, Special Provisions, and Cost Estimate for the roadway improvements on Koval Lane from 300 feet north of Tropicana Avenue to 500 feet north of Harmon Avenue.

Add the following to Section 2.03:

- K. Prepare final design plans for design of 1,300 LF of new 12-inch waterline in Paradise Road from Harmon Avenue to south of Naples Drive and 700 LF of new 16-inch waterline in Lamar Circle, south of Harmon Avenue using the previously submitted 60% design plans from another consultant.
- L. Incorporate the revisions from the 30% design provided by COUNTY, add FAST ITS conduit, prepare right-of-way documents, and provide coordination with adjacent Airport Peaking Basin and Outfall System project and Clark County Department of Aviation.

ARTICLE V: PAYMENT FOR SERVICES

Revise the first paragraph in 5.01 as follows:

5.01 Maximum Amount Payable

The maximum amount payable by the COUNTY to the ENGINEER shall be a sum of money equal to the Basic Services fees plus the Special Service fees, if, as, and when approved by the Director, and provided, however, that under no circumstances may the total amount payable to the ENGINEER under this Contract or in connection with the subject matter of this Contract, exceed the sum of One Million Five Hundred Seventy-Nine Thousand and 00/100 Dollars (\$1,579,000.00) for the Basic Service fees, and Two Hundred Ninety-Eight Thousand and 00/100 Dollars (\$298,000.00) for Special Services fees, unless such sum is increased by the Clark County Board of Commissioners, but only to the extent such total sum is increased.

Revise the last paragraph in 5.02 as follows:

5.02 Basic Services and Special Services Fees

In no event may the fees exceed the following Basic Services and the Special Services fees shown below in purposes or amounts:

The remainder of the Contract remains unchanged.
