SUMMARY – An ordinance amending Title 4, Chapter 4.18, to remove the sunset provision on the sales and use tax imposed to fund programs for early childhood, workforce education, programs to reduce truancy or homelessness, and development of affordable housing, as authorized by AB 309 of the 2019 Nevada Legislature.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 4, CHAPTER 4.18, TO REMOVE THE SUNSET PROVISION ON THE SALES AND USE TAX IMPOSED TO FUND PROGRAMS FOR EARLY CHILDHOOD, WORKFORCE EDUCATION, PROGRAMS TO REDUCE TRUANCY OR HOMELESSNESS, AND DEVELOPMENT OF AFFORDABLE HOUSING, AS AUTHORIZED BY AB 309 OF THE 2019 NEVADA LEGISLATURE; AND PROVIDING FOR OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO.

WHEREAS, the 2019 Nevada Legislature adopted AB 309 which authorizes a board of county commissioners to adopt an ordinance by a two-thirds vote of the members of the board, which imposes a sales and use tax, the proceeds of which may be distributed to a city, county or school district to pay the costs of (a) one or more programs of early childhood education operated by the county school district or any public school in the county school district; (b) one or more programs of adult education operated by the county school district or any public school in the county school district; (c) one or more programs to reduce truancy; (d) one or more programs to reduce homelessness; (e) the development or redevelopment of affordable housing or ensuring the availability or affordability of

housing, including, without limitation, any infrastructure or services to support the development or redevelopment of affordable housing; (f) incentives for the recruitment or retention of licensed teachers for high-vacancy schools in the county school district; and (g) one or more joint labor-management programs of workforce training in the hospitality industry; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners exercised this authority but limited its term to June 30, 2021; and

WHEREAS, the Board wishes to continue the programs funded by this imposition of tax;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF CLARK, STATE OF NEVADA, DOES HEREBY ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION ONE. Section Eleven, the sunset provision of Clark County Ordinance No. 4721 directing that the taxes imposed thereunder shall cease to be assessed after June 30, 2021 is hereby repealed, and the taxes imposed pursuant to that ordinance shall continue in effect from this date until repealed by this Board or the Nevada Legislature.

SECTION TWO. Upon the passage of this ordinance, the County shall notify the State Department of Taxation of the continuation of this tax.
