

**SUPPLEMENTAL NO. 1 TO THE
PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERING SERVICES CONTRACT FOR
JONES BOULEVARD, TROPICANA AVENUE TO CLARK COUNTY 215 BELTWAY**

THIS Supplemental No. 1 Contract, made and entered into this 6th day of September, 2022, between Clark County, Nevada, a political subdivision of the State of Nevada, hereinafter referred to as COUNTY, and HDR Engineering, Inc., a corporation authorized to do business under the laws of the State of Nevada, hereinafter referred to as ENGINEER. The COUNTY and ENGINEER may herein be referred individually as "Party" or collectively as "Parties".

The initial addresses of the parties, which one party may change by giving notice to the respective other party, are as follows:

W I T N E S S E T H

WHEREAS, on September 17, 2019, the COUNTY and the ENGINEER entered into a contract for professional engineering services for design services for Jones Boulevard, Tropicana Avenue to Clark County 215 Beltway and,

WHEREAS, the design requires updates because of a project being designed in-house by the COUNTY at the intersection of Jones Boulevard and Hacienda Avenue, and the COUNTY desires the ENGINEER to perform additional professional engineering design services in an amount not to exceed \$10,757.57 in Basic Services in order to complete the final plans and specifications for the Project, and,

WHEREAS, the Project design is nearing completion and additional funds are needed to provide Post-Design Services, Record Drawings, and Electronic Record Drawings, and the COUNTY desires the ENGINEER to perform the additional professional engineering design services in an amount not to exceed \$50,249.36 in Special Services to complete the Project, and,

WHEREAS, the ENGINEER desires to provide such services in exchange for the fees hereinafter specified; and,

WHEREAS, this Supplemental No. 1 increases funding by \$61,006.93 and brings the total contract amount to \$365,671.93.

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the premises and mutual covenants herein contained, it is agreed to supplement the professional engineering service contract dated September 17, 2019, as follows:

ARTICLE II: SCOPE OF SERVICES

2.02 Basic Engineering Services add the following paragraphs:

- E. Provide one additional submittal to utility companies and governmental agencies with plans and specifications for the Project to obtain approvals. The additional submittal is required due to delays caused by the acquisition of right of way.
- T. Update the Special Provision to reflect changes to the Uniform Standard Specifications for Public Works' Construction Off Site Improvements, Clark County Area, Nevada. The updates are required due to delays caused by the acquisition of right of way.

2.03 Special Services add the following paragraph

Additional Engineering Services: Upon notification by the Director, provide additional engineering and related services required for and related to the Project. The ENGINEER is authorized to perform the additional work as provided in 2.03F, 2.03H, and 2.03I of the above Professional Engineering Services Contract, signed September 17, 2019.

ARTICLE V: PAYMENT FOR SERVICES

5.01 Maximum Amount Payable

The first paragraph in this section shall be changed to read as follows:

The maximum amount payable by the COUNTY to the ENGINEER shall be a sum of money equal to the Basic Services fees, plus the Special Services fees, if, as, and when approved by the Director, and provided, however, that under no circumstances may the total amount payable to the ENGINEER under this Contract or in connection with the subject matter of this Contract, exceed the sum of Two Hundred Sixty Five Thousand Four Hundred Twenty-Two and 57/100 Dollars (\$265,422.57) for the Basic Services fees, and One Hundred Thousand Two Hundred Forty-Nine and 36/100 Dollars (\$100,249.36) for Special Services fees, unless such sum is increased by the Clark County Board of Commissioners, but only to the extent such total sum is increased.

5.02 Basic Services and Special Services Fees

The fees shall be changed to read as follows:

The remainder of the Professional Engineering Services Contract dated September 17, 2019, remains unchanged.

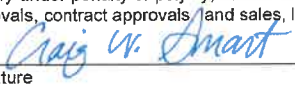
