BACKGROUND:

On April 3, 2025, Clark County and the Clark County Prosecutors Association (CCPA) reached a tentative agreement for the collective bargaining agreement. The CCPA membership voted and ratified the agreement on April 10, 2025.

Of the entire agreement, nine (9) articles and one (1) appendix was amended.
