SUPPLEMENTAL NO. 1 TO THE PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERING SERVICES CONTRACT FOR TROPICANA AVENUE AND BROADBENT BOULEVARD – BOULDER HIGHWAY TO CITY OF HENDERSON LIMITS

THIS Supplemental No. 1 Contract, made and entered into this ______ day of _______ day of ________, 2023, between CLARK COUNTY, NEVADA, a political subdivision of the State of Nevada, hereinafter referred to as "COUNTY", and JACOBS ENGINEERING GROUP, INC., a corporation authorized to do business under the laws of the State of Nevada, hereinafter referred to as "ENGINEER". The COUNTY and ENGINEER may herein be referred individually as "Party" or collectively as "Parties".

WITNESSETH

WHEREAS, on July 20, 2021, the COUNTY and the ENGINEER entered into a Professional Engineering Services Contract for Preliminary and Final design services for roadway improvements on Tropicana Avenue and Broadbent Boulevard from Boulder Highway to City of Henderson Limits; and

WHEREAS, the COUNTY desires the ENGINEER to perform additional design engineering services for the Clark County Regional Flood Control District's ("CCRFCD") facilities LV01 0001 to LV01 0135 and LV01 0151 to LV01 0176; and

WHEREAS this Supplemental No. 1 increase of \$1,455,000.00 revises the total contract value to \$2,813,357.00.

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the premises and mutual covenants herein contained, the parties agree to supplement the Professional Engineering Services Contract dated July 20, 2021 as follows:

ARTICLE I: DEFINITIONS

Add the following to Article I: Definitions

Exhibit "AA" for Direct Salaries effective September 1, 2023.

"P.L.S." is a professional licensed land surveyor in the State of Nevada, performing services for this Project.

"Project Manager" is the designated person for the ENGINEER, who shall be responsible for all services to be performed under this Contract.

Add the following to the definition of "Project" in Article I: Definitions

CCRFCD Master Plan Update ("MPU") facility improvements include Final Design of Facilities LV01 0001 to LV01 0135, from Clark County Wetlands Park to Andover Drive. Such improvements to include 100-year CCRFCD MPU facilities, drop inlets, Geotechnical engineering, utility relocation, survey mapping, ground water analysis, pavements patches, and Nevada Department of Transportation ("NDOT") permits to sixty (60) percent, ninety (90) percent, and Final design level. This design will be added to the current sixty (60) percent design for the Tropicana Avenue and Broadbent Roadway Project. The "Project" will also update the current thirty (30) percent design of the CCRFCD MPU Facilities LV01 0151 to LV01 0176 from Andover Drive to Mountain Vista Street. Such improvements include 100-year CCRFCD MPU facilities, preliminary drop inlets, based on any changes impacting the current thirty (30) percent design resulting from the final design of the Andover drive to Wetlands Park.

ARTICLE II: SCOPE OF SERVICES

2.02 Basic Engineering Services

Add the following to the end of Subsections 2.02 A through 2.02 O, and Subsections 2.02 Q through Section 202 Y:

Deliverable: The design of flood control improvements for CCRFCD MPU Facilities LV01 0001 to LV01 0135, Clark County Wetlands Park to Andover Drive.

Add the following to the end of subsections 2.02 P, and 2.02 Q:

Deliverable: The updated thirty (30) percent design of flood control improvements for CCRFCD MPU Facilities LV01 0151 to LV01 0176 from the Andover Drive to Mountain Vista Street.

ARTICLE IV: TIME OF PERFORMANCE

4.01 Time of Performance

Delete and replace this Section with the following:

Subject to Section 4.02 hereof, the ENGINEER shall complete the following specific tasks, and all the work preceding such tasks on or before the date set out below:

2.02X	Bidding Assistance Phase	Beginning when Project is advertised and lasting until Project is awarded to low bidder.
2.03	Special Services	Within time period as specified by the Director.

The ENGINEER shall complete all other Basic Services and authorized Special Services by the end of December 31, 2025, unless the Board of County Commissioners amends such date in writing.

ARTICLE V: PAYMENT FOR SERVICES

5.01 Maximum Amount Payable

Delete the first paragraph in this Section and replace with the following:

The maximum amount payable by the COUNTY to the ENGINEER shall be a sum of money equal to the Basic Services fees plus the Special Service fees, if, as, and when approved by the Director, and provided, however, that under no circumstances may the total amount payable to the ENGINEER under this Contract or in connection with the subject matter of this Contract, exceed the sum of Two Million Four Hundred Ninety Three Thousand Three Hundred Fifty-Seven and 00/100 Dollars (\$2,493,357.00) for the Basic Service fees, and Three Hundred Twenty Thousand and 00/100 Dollars (\$320,000.00) for Special Services fees, unless such sum is increased by the Clark County Board of Commissioners, but only to the extent such total sum is increased.

5.02 **Basic Services and Special Services Fees**

Delete the last paragraph in this Section and replace with the following:

In no event may the fees exceed the following Basic Services and the Special Services fees shown below in purposes or amounts:




