

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE FIRE CHIEF TO ISSUE FIRE RESTRICTION ORDERS TO MITIGATE THE RISK OF FIRES DURING HAZARDOUS BURNING CONDITIONS

WHEREAS, the Mount Charleston Fire Protection District (hereinafter "District") was established July 1, 2015, pursuant to NRS 474.460 and Clark County Code 3.22.020;

WHEREAS, the District is governed by the Mount Charleston Board of Fire Commissioners (hereinafter "Board");

WHEREAS, Clark County Code 3.22.020 sets the boundaries of the Mount Charleston Fire Protection District, which includes private property located within those boundaries (hereinafter "Mount Charleston");

WHEREAS, the Board finds that Mount Charleston has an increased risk of damage to property due to the potential for wildfires and fire restrictions are necessary to protect the property located at Mount Charleston; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, to protect Mount Charleston from fires in accordance with NRS 474.460, the Board, effective upon passage of this Resolution authorizes the Fire Chief of the District to issue fire restriction orders to mitigate the risk of wildfires when the Fire Chief determines that the atmospheric conditions or local circumstances make open burning hazardous.
