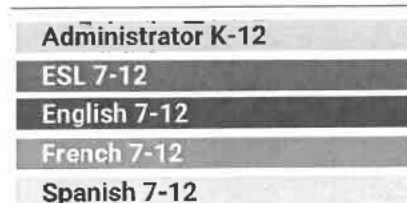

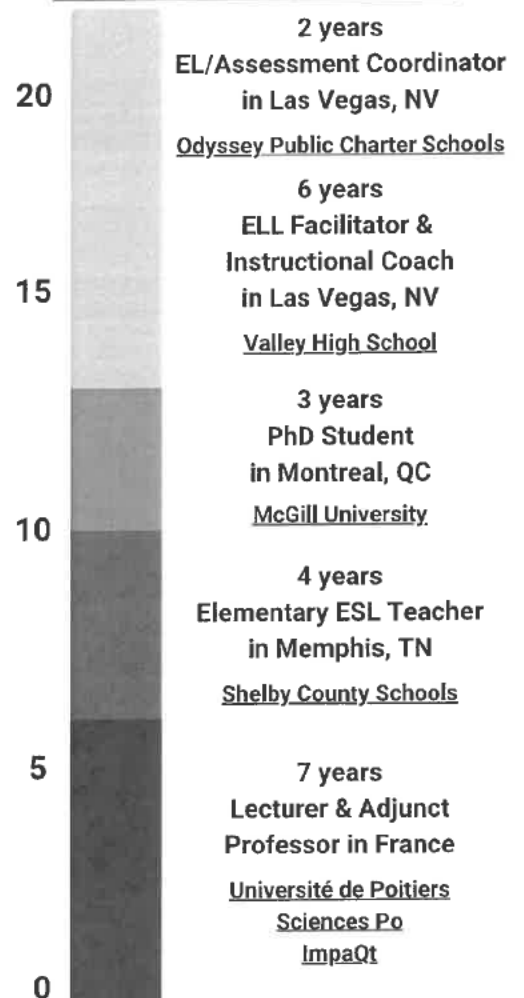

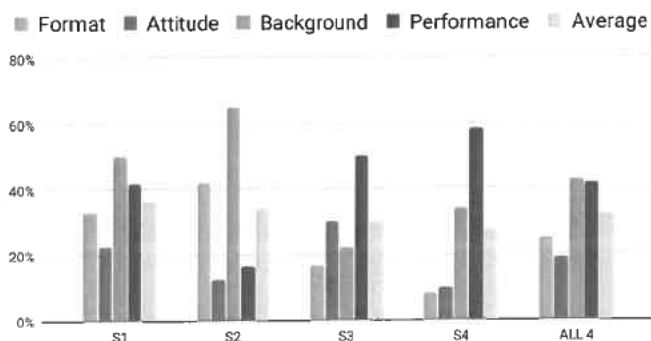
WIDA PILOT STUDY 2019

I led a team of teachers to develop an intervention plan for improving Long Term English Learner WIDA Scores. Students increased an average of 32% across all measures, which corresponded to them exiting LEP Status.

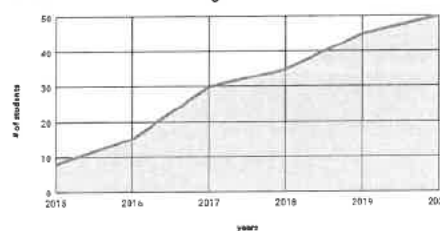
CIRCLES CORRELATE WITH NUMBER OF STUDENTS.
