





What Changed?

- Mental Health Staffing
 - Two (2) Board Certified Psychiatrists
- Increased quality of assessments throughout inmate's incarceration
 - Thorough screening process in Booking to include co-occurring concerns
- Increased engagement
 - Mid-Level & Psychiatrists visits
 - Rounding in Administrative Segregation Housing
 - Post Suicide Watch follow-ups
 - 24 Hours / 7 Days / 14 Days in addition to other mental health engagement
- Established Validated Mental Health Programming in seven (7) modules
- Aligned our processes to match National Commission on Correctional Health Care (NCCHC)
 - Weekly Restrictive Housing Meetings
 - Mental Health Training




