

## **RESOLUTION TO CREATE THE 9-1-1 SURCHARGE FUND (2395)**

**WHEREAS**, NRS 244A.7643 authorizes the Board of County Commissioners to adopt an ordinance imposing a 9-1-1 telephone line surcharge to enhance the County's 9-1-1 system and to purchase and maintain portable and vehicular event recording devices and other purposes expressly authorized under NRS 244A.7645, as set forth in the County's Five-Year 9-1-1 Master Plan; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board has adopted CHAPTER 4.35 imposing a monthly surcharge, effective April 1, 2026, beginning at \$0.50 per access (local exchange) line, \$5.00 per trunk line, and \$0.50 per mobile telephone number, with annual increases of \$0.10 for local exchange and mobile lines and \$1.00 for trunk lines until maximums of \$1.00 for local exchange and mobile lines and \$10.00 for trunk lines are reached; and

**WHEREAS**, telephone companies will collect the surcharge, may retain an amount equal to their cost of collection, and will remit net receipts to the County Treasurer; and

**WHEREAS**, all surcharge revenues must be deposited into a special fund and expended solely for purposes authorized by NRS 244A.7645; and

**WHEREAS**, CHAPTER 4.35 establishes the Clark County 9-1-1 Emergency Response Advisory Committee to develop, maintain, and annually review the Five-Year Master Plan and to recommend surcharge expenditures to the Board; and

**WHEREAS**, NRS 354.612 and NAC 354.241 require that local government entities adopt a resolution establishing new funds and setting forth the purpose of the fund and plan for administration.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of County Commissioners of Clark County, Nevada, as follows:

1. A new fund called the 9-1-1 Surcharge Fund (2395) shall be created as a Special Revenue Fund, effective April 1, 2026.
2. The purpose of the fund is to account for all revenues generated by the 9-1-1 telephone line surcharge and to finance enhancements to Clark County's 9-1-1 system and the acquisition, maintenance, and operation of portable and vehicular event recording devices and other expenditures authorized under NRS 244A.7645.
3. The source of revenues for the fund shall be surcharge receipts remitted by telephone companies, and any associated interest earnings.
4. Expenditures from the fund shall be made only in accordance with Board direction and in compliance with NRS 244A.7645 and the County's Five-Year 9-1-1 Master Plan (Master Plan),
