Clark County Sewage and Wastewater Advisory Committee (SWAC):

- Required by NRS 244A, “County Sewage and Wastewater Law”
- To remain aware and discuss all matters related to wastewater treatment, stormwater quality, and general water quality in the County
- An advisory committee to the Board of County Commissioners on wastewater/water quality matters that may require action by the Board

SWAC OPERATIONS

- Meets quarterly or more frequently, if necessary
- Subject to the Open Meeting Law
- Administered by Clark County Water Quality (managed by and located at CCWRD)
- Current Chair is Dan Fischer of CCWRD
- Reports water and wastewater flows by month
- Meeting agendas include an analysis of flows, member agency updates, and presentations related to water, wastewater, and watershed matters
- Facilitates communication and collaboration among SWAC members and other local, state, and federal agencies
