Thank you for the opportunity to apply for reappointment to the Spring Valley Town Advisory Board. It has been my privilege to serve on this TAB as both a member and its Chair. I would like to continue.

As you are aware we in Spring Valley have seen some significant development in recent years and it has been exciting to play a role in that process. Our focus on neighborhood development that is created by strong economic development has been gratifying and exciting to see.
