WITNESSETH

WHEREAS, on August 2, 2016, the COUNTY and the ENGINEER entered into a contract for professional engineering services ("Contract") for design services for Jones Boulevard, Blue Diamond Road to Windmill Lane; and,

WHEREAS, on December 21, 2021, the COUNTY and the ENGINEER entered into Supplemental No. 1 to the Contract to extend the time of performance due to delays caused by the acquisition of right of way; and,

WHEREAS, on May 17, 2022, the COUNTY, R2H Engineering, Inc., R2H Engineering, Inc. d/b/a Horrocks Engineers, Inc., and Horrocks Engineers, Inc. entered into an Assignment Agreement to assign the Contract from R2H Engineering, Inc. to R2H Engineering, Inc. d/b/a Horrocks Engineers, Inc.; and,

WHEREAS, on June 21, 2022, the COUNTY and the ENGINEER entered into Supplemental No. 2 to the Contract to increase total funds for additional design services; and,

WHEREAS, the Contract is seven (7) years old and the ENGINEER'S labor rates no longer represents the current labor market; and,

WHEREAS, the COUNTY desires to update the ENGINEER'S labor rates to current labor market rates; and,

WHEREAS, the Project's construction will be ongoing for another two (2) years and beyond the current expiration date of the Contract; and,

WHEREAS, the COUNTY desires to extend the time of performance which is required to complete all Basic Services and authorized Special Services; and,

WHEREAS, the Contract Special Service amount has been utilized for additional designs and post design construction support; and,

WHEREAS, the COUNTY desires to add additional Special Service in the amount not to exceed \$50,000; and,

WHEREAS, this Supplemental No. 3 increases funding by \$50,000.00 which brings the total contract amount to \$1,440,404.00.

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the premises and mutual covenants herein contained, it is agreed to supplement the Professional Engineering Service Contract dated August 2, 2016, Supplemental No. 1 to the Contract dated December 21, 2021, and Supplemental No. 2 to the Contract dated June 21, 2022, as follows:

ARTICLE IV: TIME OF PERFORMANCE

4.01 Time of Performance

Replace the last paragraph of this section with the following:

Except as otherwise set forth above, the ENGINEER shall complete all Basic Services and authorized Special Services within the completion times prior to June 30, 2026, unless such date is amended by the COUNTY.

ARTICLE V: PAYMENT FOR SERVICES

5.01 Maximum Amount Payable

Revise the first paragraph in this section to read as follows:

The maximum amount payable by the COUNTY to the ENGINEER shall be a sum of money equal to the Basic Service fees plus the Special Services fees, if, as, and when approved by the Director, and provided, however, that under no circumstances may the total amount payable to the ENGINEER under this Contract or in connection with the subject matter of this Contract, exceed the sum of Nine Hundred Eighty Five Thousand One Hundred Twenty-Nine and 00/100 Dollars (\$985,129.00) for the Basic Services fees, and up to Four Hundred Fifty Five Thousand Two Hundred Seventy-Five and 00/100
