**I would like to introduce myself. I have been a resident of Clark County since 1951. I moved here with my parents and sisters from Hammond, Indiana just before my 12<sup>th</sup> birthday. I went to John S. Park elementary school for the 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grade graduating in 1953. I went to Las Vegas High School and graduated in 1957. I moved back to Hammond, Indiana and went to work for my cousins and learned the Ready Mix Concrete business. I received my draft notice in September of 1960 and moved back to Las Vegas. I went to work for Las Vegas Building Materials as a Teamster Local 631 ready mix concrete truck driver. I joined the US Navy Reserve in October 1961 in the Sea Bees. I was on active duty from October 1962 to August 1964. I returned to my job at Las Vegas Building Materials. I spent from 1960 until 2000 driving a concrete truck for 3 different companies helping build Southern Nevada. I retired from the Teamster's Local 631 with full retirement benefits in 2000. I was a Shop Steward for 24 years at Las Vegas Building Materials. I pushed for retirement benefits and seniority along with other benefits we received. I worked for PSSI/Strategic Television for 16 years as a Resource Manager and retired in May 2016.**

**I have been married for 61 years, my wife is a native Las Vegan and we have one son, a member of the Operating Engineers Local 12 and three grandsons.**

**In 1990 my wife and I became involved in neighborhood zoning issues and what was happening in our area.
