## **BACKGROUND:**

This Contract is for Disclosure Counsel services with Taft, Stettinius & Hollister LLP (LBE).

A Fiscal Directive No. 6, Competitive Bidding Exception, was approved because this firm recently acquired the County's previous provider. Given the upcoming Legislative session, positive arbitrage environment, and the complexity surrounding the upcoming bond issue for the Major League Baseball stadium, the County needs to ensure it has a provider in place that is already familiar with the intricacies of the complex nature of the federal tax laws and the County's bond transactions.

The following are the pertinent provisions of the Contract:

- The term of the Contract is from date of award through December 31, 2025, and includes the option to renew for 6, one-year periods and includes a 3-month extension.
- Includes the County's option to terminate for cause, convenience or default and suspend the Contract with advanced written notice.

The recommendation of award is in accordance with NRS 332.115.1(b), the competitive bidding process is not required as the services to be performed are professional in nature.
