THIRD AMENDMENT TO CLARK COUNTY CORONAVIRUS STATE AND LOCAL GOVERNMENT FISCAL RECOVERY FUNDS (FISCAL RECOVERY FUNDS) PROGRAM RESOLUTION

THIS AMENDMENT effective May 6, 2025, ("Amendment") is made and entered into by and between CLARK COUNTY, NEVADA, ("Clark County") and the JEWISH FAMILY SERVICE AGENCY ("Recipient"), collectively referred to as the Parties ("Parties").

WHEREAS, on April 27, 2022, the Parties entered into a Resolution ("Resolution") to grant to Recipient up to \$900,000 of Coronavirus State and Local Fiscal Recovery Funds (CFDA #21.027) for the Recipient's COUNSELING - BEHAVIORAL HEALTH PROGRAM ("Program").

WHEREAS, on September 6, 2023, the Parties entered into the First Amendment to extend the term of the grant award from December 31, 2023 to December 31, 2024.

WHEREAS, on December 3, 2024, the Parties entered into the Second Amendment to reallocate the remaining grant balance of \$423,088.39 from federal Coronavirus State and Local Fiscal Recovery Funds (CFDA #21.027) to non-federal Clark County Recovery Funds and extend term of the grant award to December 31, 2025.

WHEREAS, the Parties desire to reduce the remaining grant balance of non-federal Clark County Recovery Funds.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants and agreements contained herein and, in the Resolution, the parties agree as follows:

1. To change the reference of the remaining balance of Clark County Recovery Funds from \$423,088.39 to \$323,674.66.
