Increase fence height to 11 feet where a maximum height of 6 feet is permitted per Section 30.04.03B (an 83% increase).

Site Plan & Elevations

The plan depicts an existing single-family residence with primary access from Crowntop Circle to the west. The proposed fence is located at the northeast corner of the lot, positioned 1 foot from the existing block wall to the east and 7 feet from the existing residence to the south. The fence is designed to be 11 feet in height and finished in a Maplewood color to match the existing single-family residence.

Landscaping

No landscaping is proposed with this request.

Applicant's Justification

The intent of the proposed fence location and height is to provide privacy. The applicant states there are no objections from neighbors.

STANDARDS FOR APPROVAL:

The applicant shall demonstrate that the proposed request is consistent with the Master Plan and is in compliance with Title 30.

Analysis

Comprehensive Planning

Waiver of Development Standards

The applicant shall have the burden of proof to establish that the proposed request is appropriate for its proposed location by showing the following: 1) the use(s) of the area adjacent to the subject property will not be affected in a substantially adverse manner; 2) the proposal will not materially affect the health and safety of persons residing in, working in, or visiting the immediate vicinity, and will not be materially detrimental to the public welfare; and 3) the proposal will be adequately served by, and will not create an undue burden on, any public improvements, facilities, or services.

The intent of limiting fence height is to maintain a consistent development pattern and reduce potential negative impacts on neighboring properties. While the proposed fence incorporates a Maplewood finish to visually complement the existing residence, the applicant did not provide sufficient justification to support the fence height or its placement. Since the applicant has not provided sufficient evidence to demonstrate that the proposed deviation is warranted or that it would avoid negative impacts on adjacent properties, staff cannot support the request.

Staff Recommendation

Denial.

If this request is approved, the Board and/or Commission finds that the application is consistent with the standards and purpose enumerated in the Master Plan, Title 30, and/or the Nevada Revised Statutes.
