THIS AMENDMENT is made and entered into this 1st day of February 2021, by and between CLARK COUNTY, NEVADA (hereinafter referred to as "COUNTY"), and LISA A. DURETTE, MD, PLLC DBA HEALTHY MINDS (hereinafter referred to as "PROVIDER").

Add additional service to the Fee Schedule:

Case Management – Must be comprehensive and coordinated, include an assessment, development of a specific care plan, assistance with the enrollment in services, help participants gain access to needed medical, social, educational, and other services, plus monitoring and follow-up on these activities. (Services will not be reimbursed for referrals given to participants.)	Per Hour	\$40.00

Add the following language:

Based upon available funding and with prior Court approval, PROVIDER may seek reimbursement for the following fees:

Court Mandatory Meetings	Per Hour	\$25.00
Documented Supplies	Per Month	\$200.00
Administrative Documentation	Per Month	\$100.00
Training and travel deemed appropriate for programming and Specialty Court treatment. All training and travel must follow the GSA rates	Per Year	\$2500.00
