Proposal requests funds to purchase a powered gurney loading system that securely loads patients into the back of an ambulance. The current system is a manual load system that requires 2 to 3 personnel to safely load a patient on uneven terrain. This system would reduce possible injury to a patient/rescuer when loading patients during rescue.

This project addresses trail maintenance needs on the Fletcher Canyon Trail through on-the-ground trail work led by Friends of Nevada Wilderness. Friends staff will lead 3 volunteer events involving a total of at least 18 volunteers to address trail hazards that are degrading the recreation quality of the Spring Mountains. Trail work will include brushing, improving drainage, fixing erosion problems, clearing downed trees, and tread maintenance.
