Ratify the submittal of the FY2021-2022 Action Plan for Housing and Community Development

Summary:

The Fiscal Year 2021-2022Action Plan describes the funding allocations, by jurisdiction, for the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG), the HOME Investment Partnerships Grant (HOME), the Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG), and the Nevada Account for Affordable Housing Trust Fund (AAHTF). Total Federal funding represented in the plan is \$12,861,129. The total funding in the plan including unexpended prior year funds, Program Income and funding from the State of Nevada (State HOME and AAHTF) is \$15,808,455.

Additional points of interest include:

The Action Plan includes projects that were previously approved by the Board of County Commissioners as part of the County's five-year Capital Improvement Plan (FYs 2020-2024). During development of the five-year plan, a Community Development Advisory Committee provided citizen input on the projects based on community priorities. A public hearing for the Capital Improvement Plan took place in February 2020. In July 2020, the Board of County Commissioners approved allocation of funds for specific projects in the FY 2020-2024 Capital Improvement Plan and authorized staff to submit a Pre-Award Approval Request to HUD.

Projects that received funding as part of this year's plan are included in Attachment 1. Please note that for Clark County Capital Projects, funding amounts for the year represent only a portion of the full funding for the project, as the monies are often allocated over a period of a few years. Thus, additional funding has either already been allocated to these projects in previous years' plans or will be allocated in plans for FY 2021 and FY 2022. On the last page of this document is a listing of Clark County Capital Projects that are multiyear and their funding and status.

CDBG public service projects (done by City of Boulder City) represent one year of funding for fiscal period July 1, 2021-June 30, 2022. HOME projects receive funding approval in the current year but can take multiple years to be completed due to the nature of construction projects.

It is expected that HUD will approve the FY2021-2022 Action Plan by the end of June.
