



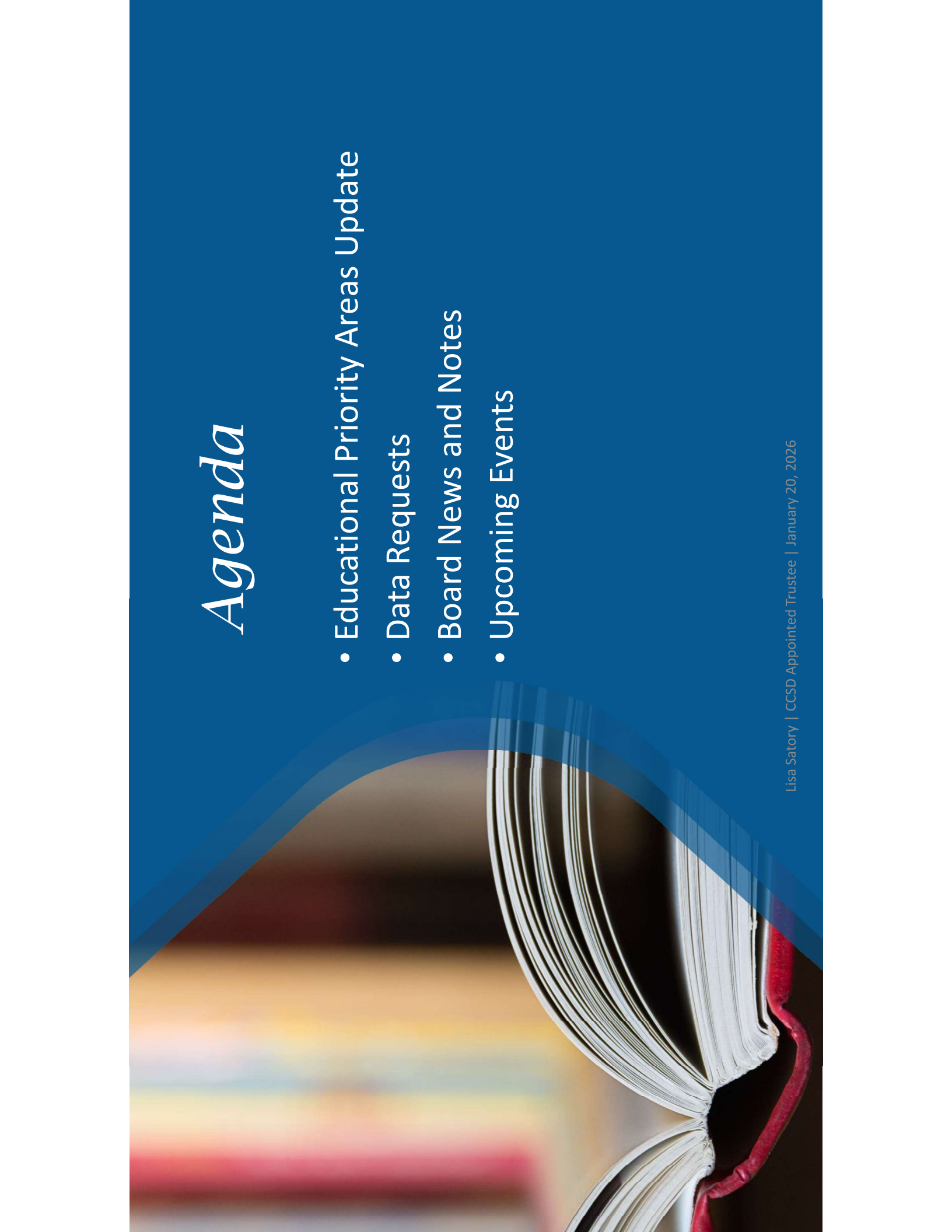

Educational Priority Areas		Research and Analysis
• Expansion of Open Schools, Open Doors • CCSD Collaboration with Clark County on children's mental health and access to services. • CCSD Collaboration with Clark County on school construction/renovation. • Identification of rural-specific education issues. • Embed the County's Truancy Prevention Outreach Program (TPOP) into CCSD. • Status of the Lundy Elementary School on Mt. Charleston • Focus on early childhood education.		• Review the governance structure of the CCSD Board of Trustees. • Determine all existing CCSD partnerships.

Educational Priority Areas Updates

- Passage of AB6 will strengthen penalties for traffic infractions in school zones to better protect our students as they travel to and from school
- Pre-K Updates- Applied for grant funds through SB460 to support pre-K infrastructure, including building modifications, playground installations, and furniture.





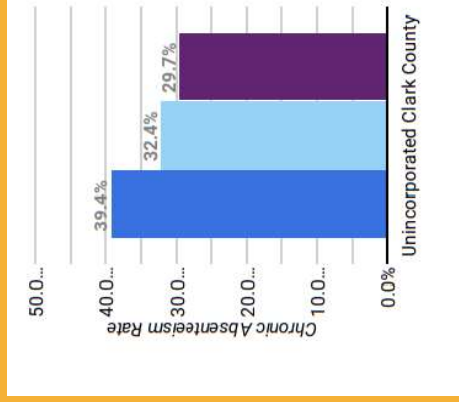
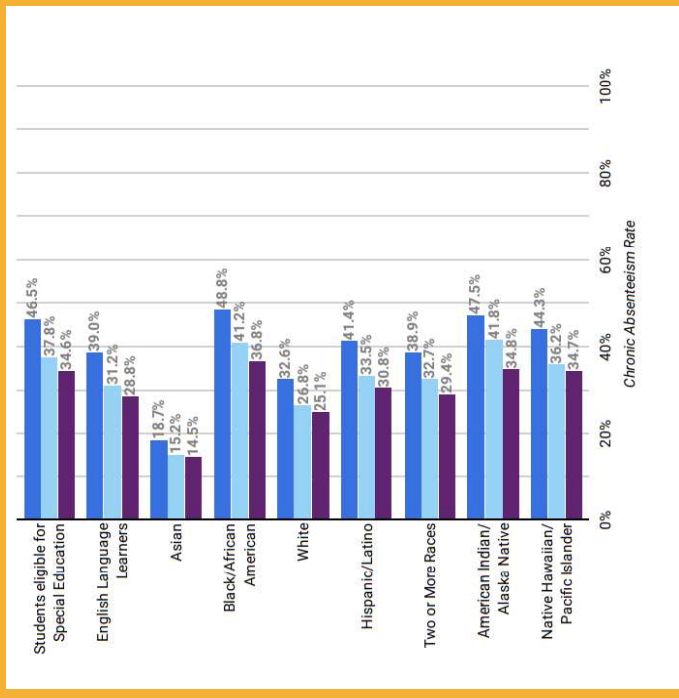
Data Requests

Follow Up From 10/21/25 Meeting

- Maintenance and Replacement Schedules
- At-Risk Funding Calculations
 - Reported using a proprietary algorithm developed by Infinite Campus rather than a simple count of economically disadvantaged students.
 - The algorithm analyzes dozens of student indicators (attendance, grades, mobility, etc.) and generates a “GRAD score.”
 - Students with the *lowest scores* are classified as at-risk for funding purposes.
 - Predictive model to decide how many students qualify as at risk and thus get the extra weighted funding.
- SB 460 aims to smooth out funding changes based on grad scores to reduce variability in school budgets

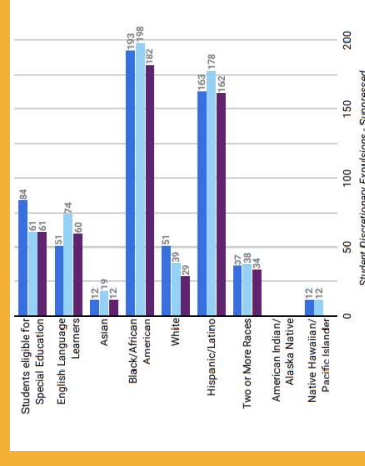
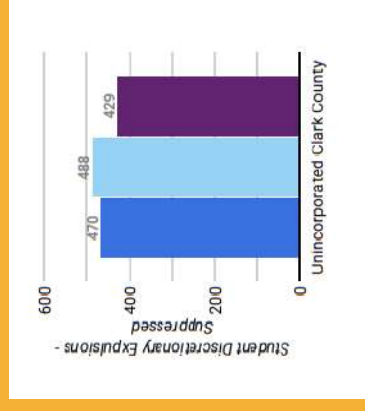
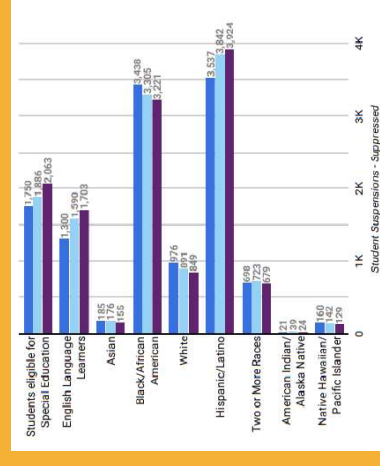
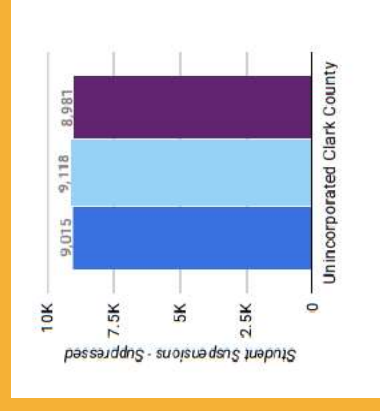

- Approval of the 2026 Amended Final Budget took place on December 11 approving the \$3.9M in General and Special Education Fund revenues for the 2025-26 school year.



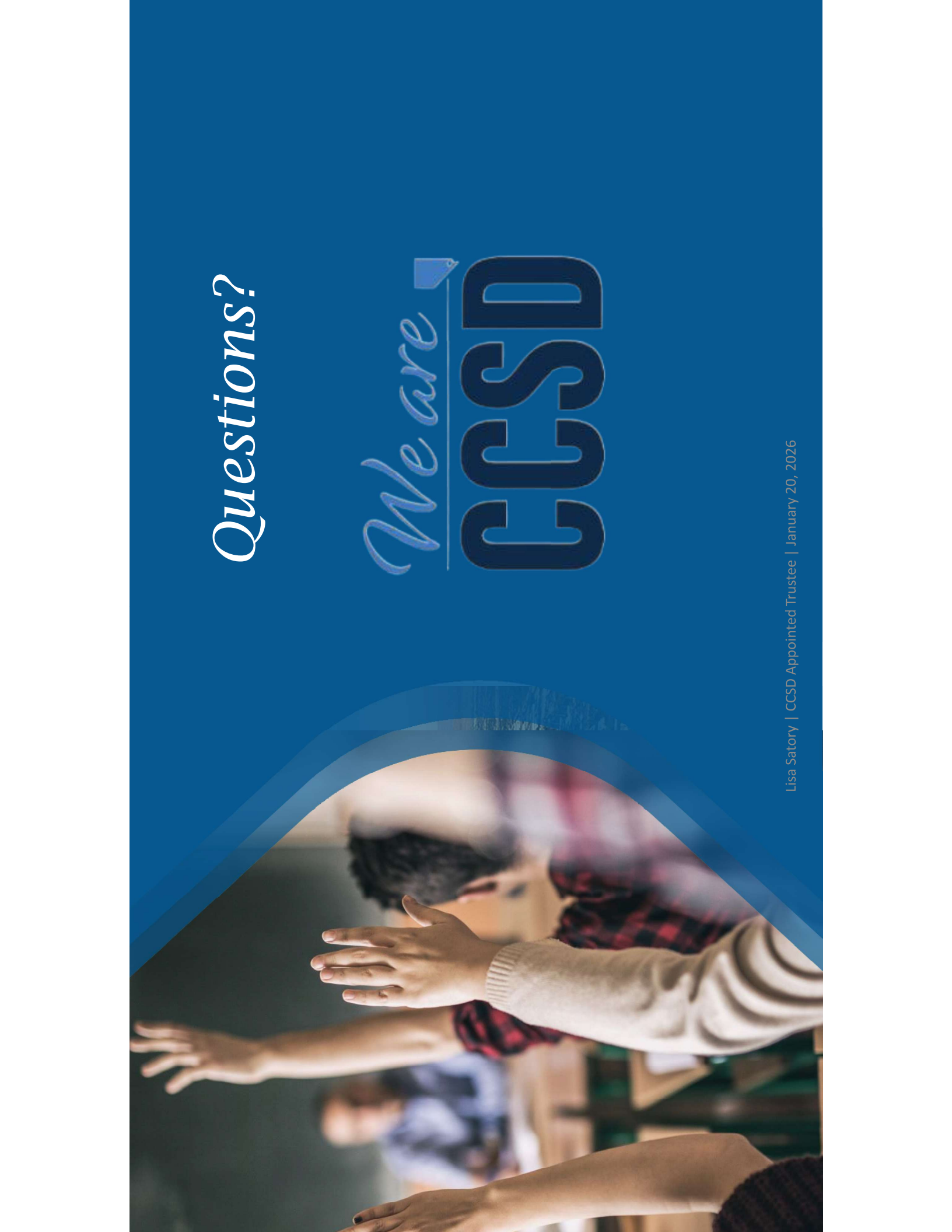
