

AMENDMENT NO. 1
RFP / INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT NO. 605440-19
OZONE FORMATION AND ITS SENSITIVITY TO NOX AND VOCS STUDY

THIS AMENDMENT is made and entered into this ____ day of _____ 2021, by and between CLARK COUNTY, NEVADA (hereinafter referred to as "COUNTY"), and NATIONAL OCEANIC AND ATMOSPHERIC ADMINISTRATION/ EARTH SYSTEM RESEARCH LABORATORY / CHEMICAL SCIENCES DIVISION, U.S. DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE (hereinafter referred to as NOAA/ESRL/CSD).

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the parties entered into an agreement under RFP Number 605440-19, entitled "Ozone Formation and Its Sensitivity to NOx and VOCs Study" dated April 21, 2020 (hereinafter referred to as CONTRACT); and

WHEREAS, the parties desire to amend the CONTRACT.

NOW, THEREFORE, the parties agree to amend the CONTRACT as follows:

1. Article III: Term of Agreement, page 2, originally read:

"The AGREEMENT term shall become effective when signed by both parties and shall terminate on June 30, 2021. Notwithstanding the foregoing provision, either party may terminate AGREEMENT, without cause, upon giving ninety (90) days written notice to the other party. In the event the Budget Act and Fiscal Fund Out provision is invoked, AGREEMENT shall expire June 30th of the current fiscal year. NOAA's continued performance is contingent upon appropriations. If NOAA has a lapse in appropriated funding during its performance under this agreement, the agreement's termination date shall automatically shift from June 30, 2021 to a date thereafter corresponding the length of NOAA's funding lapse."

Revised to read:

"The AGREEMENT term shall become effective when signed by both parties and shall terminate on June 30, 2022. Notwithstanding the foregoing provision, either party may terminate AGREEMENT, without cause, upon giving ninety (90) days written notice to the other party. In the event the Budget Act and Fiscal Fund Out provision is invoked, AGREEMENT shall expire June 30th of the current fiscal year. NOAA's continued performance is contingent upon appropriations. If NOAA has a lapse in appropriated funding during its performance under this agreement, the agreement's termination date shall automatically shift from June 30, 2022 to a date thereafter corresponding the length of NOAA's funding lapse."

This Amendment No. 1 represents a no cost change.

Except as expressly amended herein, the terms and conditions of the CONTRACT shall remain in full force and effect.


