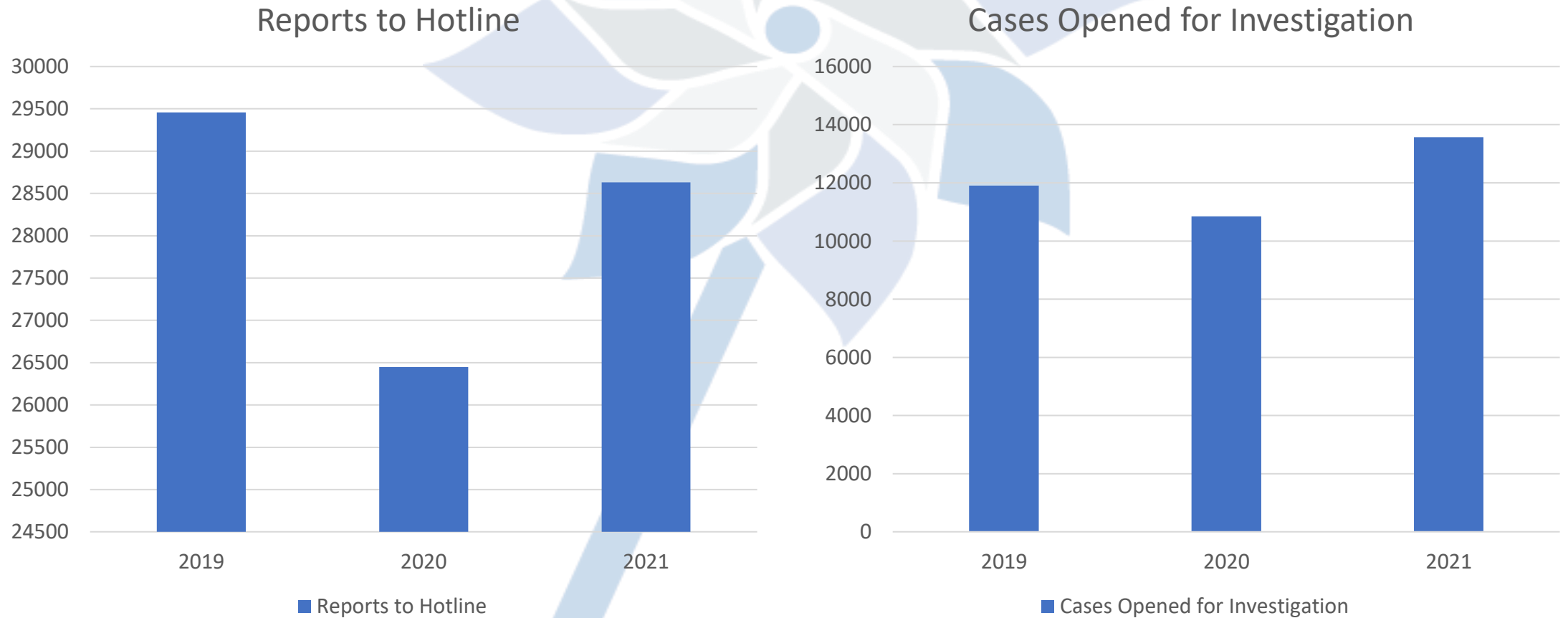




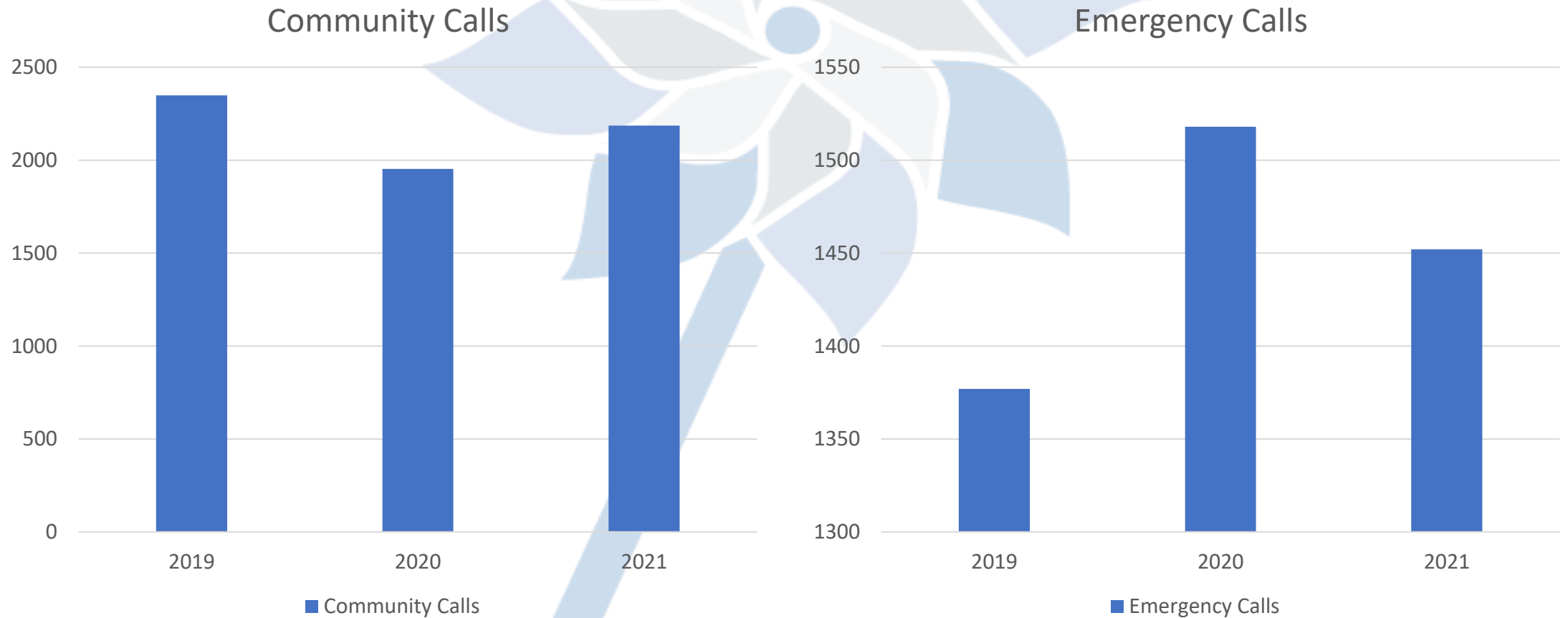

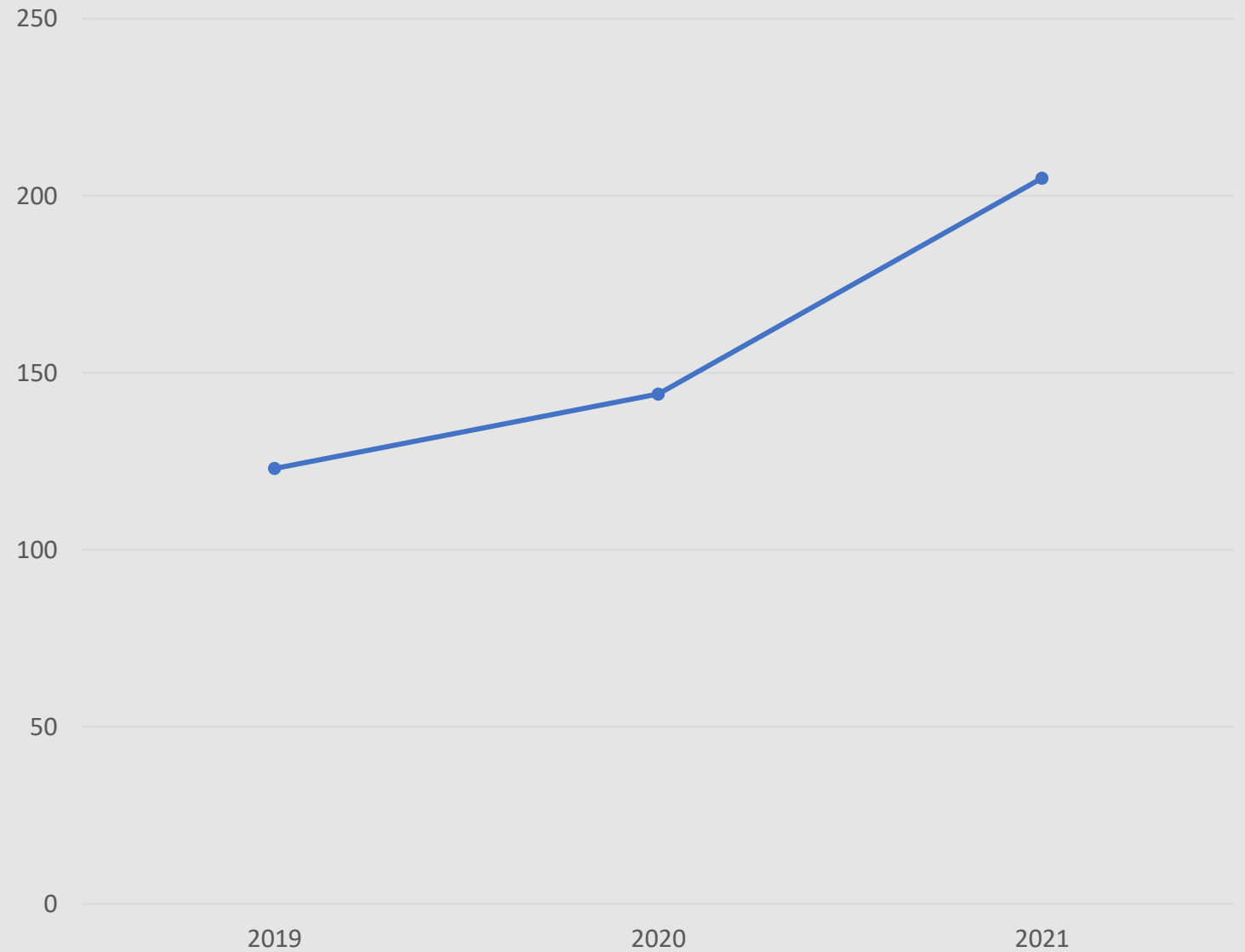
The Pandemic's Impact on Child Abuse and Neglect Reporting



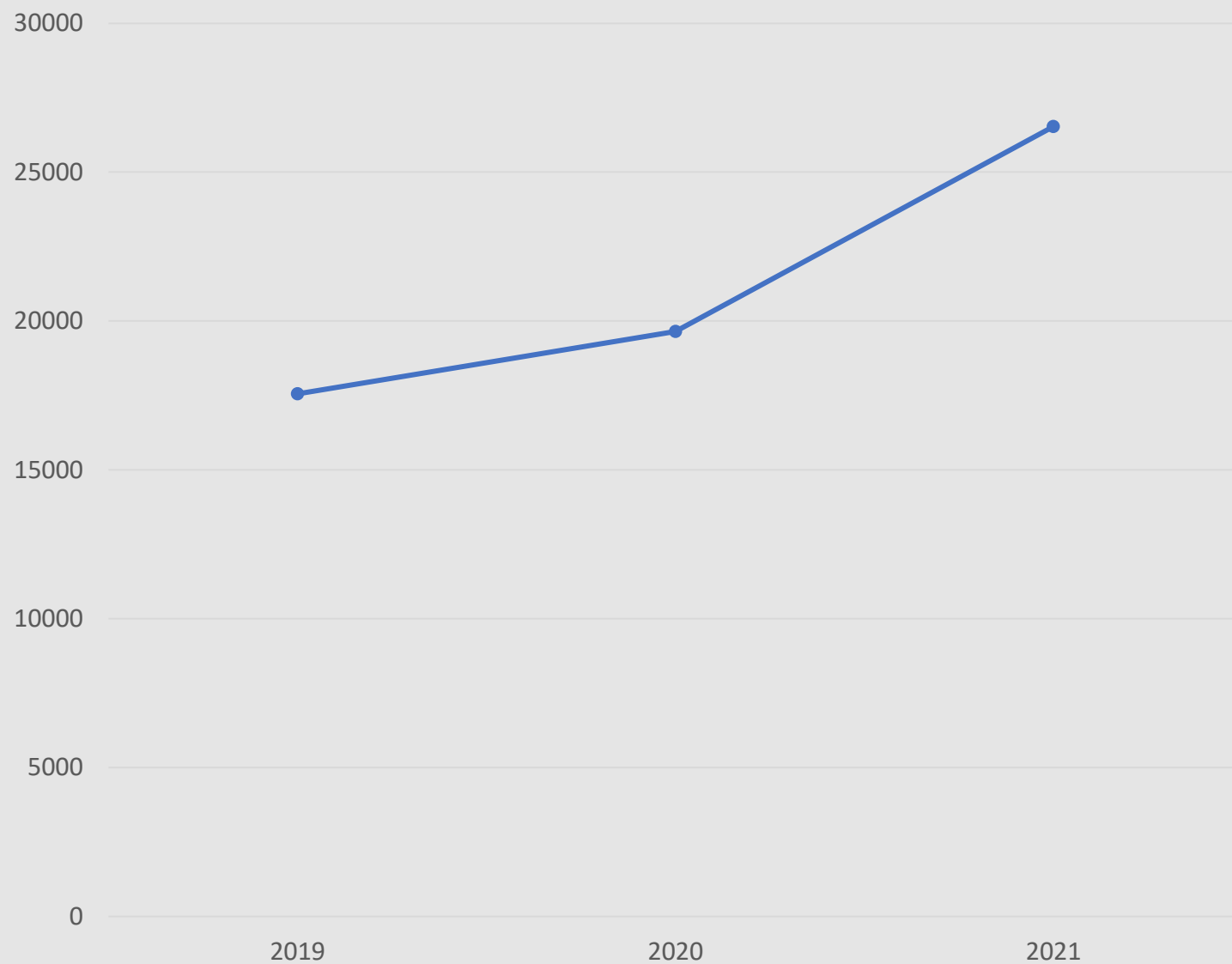
Hotline Report Source – Monthly Average



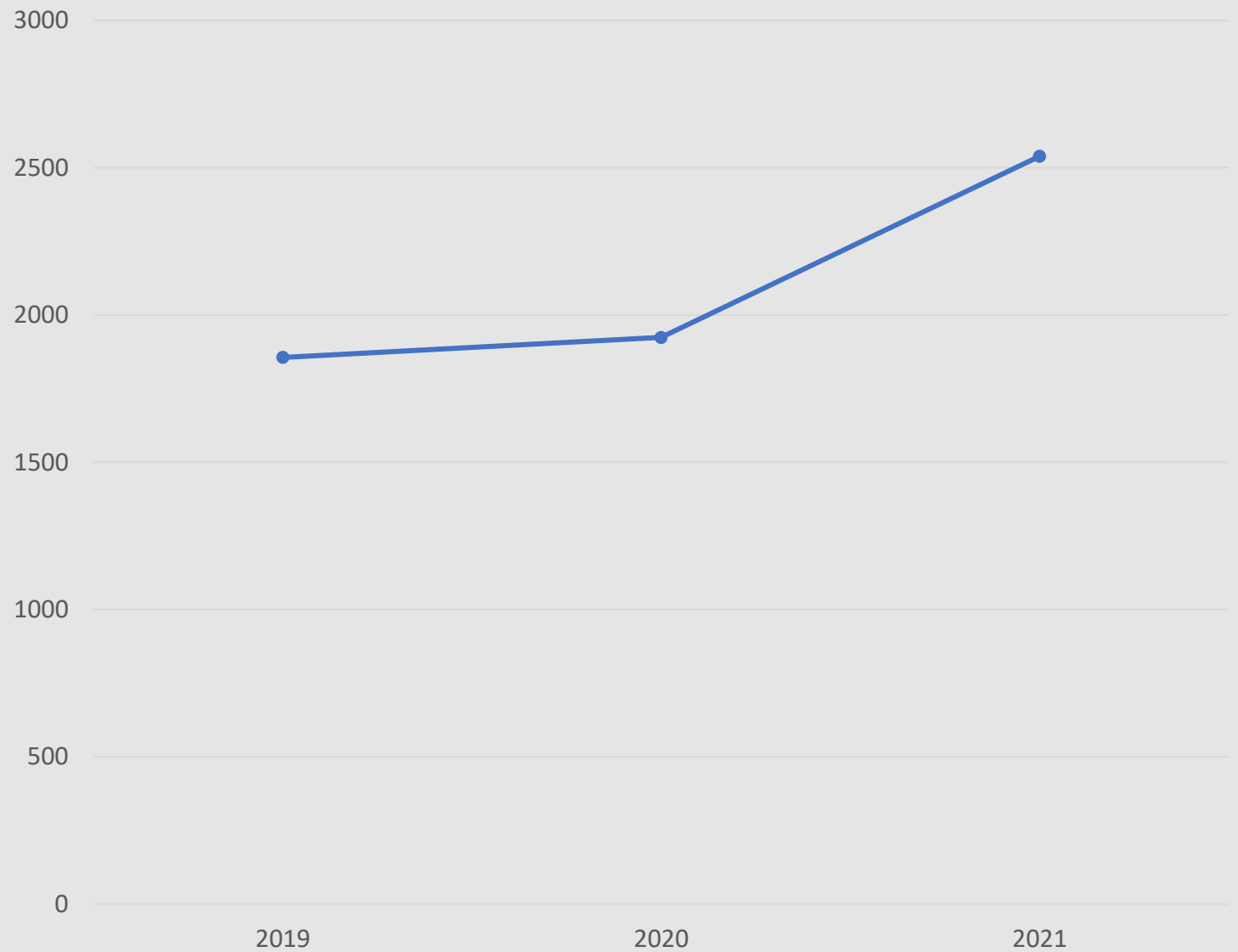
Mental Injury Allegations

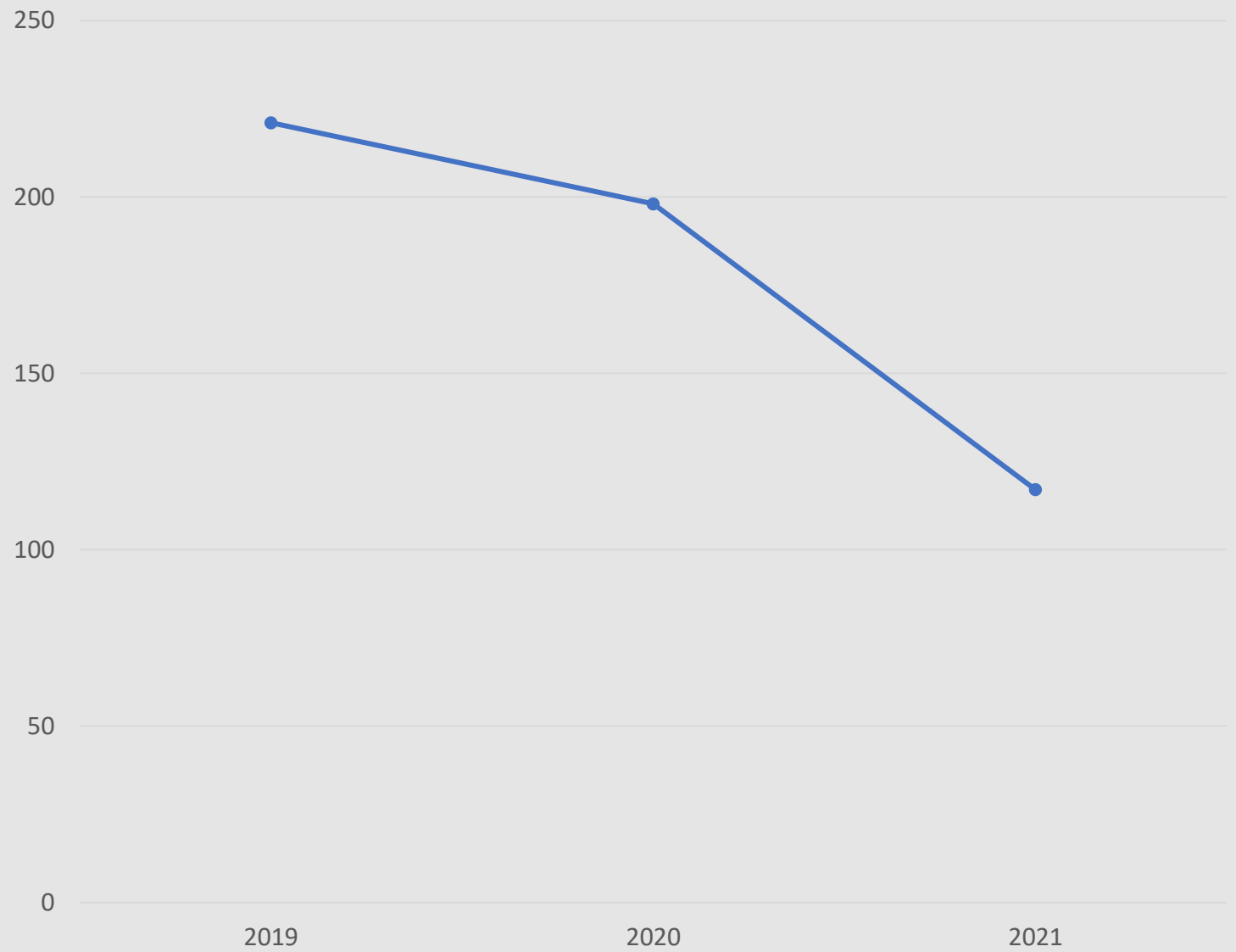




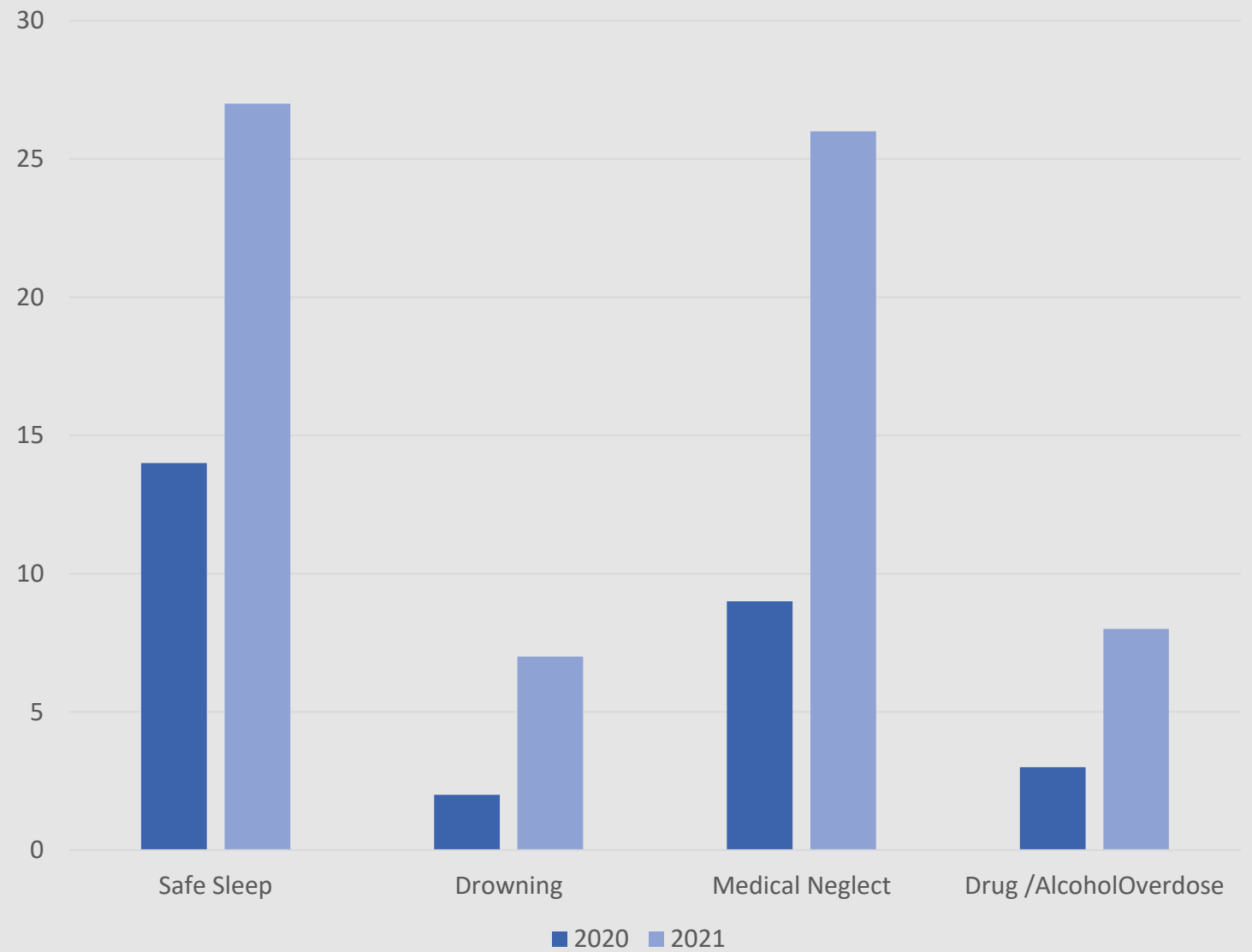

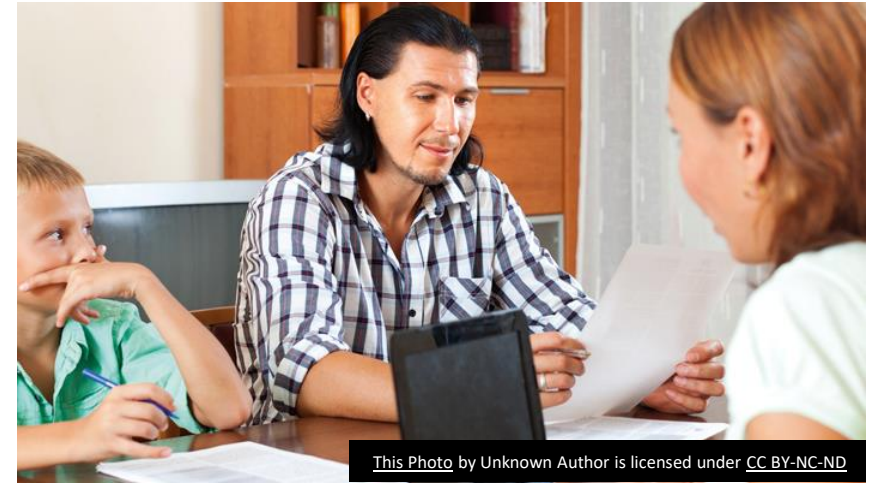
