BACKGROUND:

On August 26, 2024, Request for Qualifications (RFQ) No. 607054-24 was advertised on the Clark County Purchasing website and in the Las Vegas Review Journal. Proposals were requested for Managed Services.

The following are the pertinent provisions of the Contracts:

- The term of the Contracts are from date of award through March 31, 2030, and includes the option to renew for 5, one-year periods.
- Includes the County's option to terminate for cause, convenience or default and suspend the Contract with advanced written notice.

The recommendation of award is in accordance with NRS 332.115.1, a discretionary award process is permissible because the County requires the services of some or all qualified providers of these services and, therefore, the contract is not, by its nature, adaptable to competitive bidding. Pursuant to internal policies and procedures, Clark County solicited these services through RFQ/SOQ process.
