## **BACKGROUND:**

On January 16, 2024, the Board of County Commissioners ("BCC") approved the resolution to establish the Colorado River Heritage Greenway Park Trail Advisory Council ("Advisory Council") to perform community service and outreach related to the Colorado River parks and trails in unincorporated Clark County.

The Advisory Council broadly represents the diverse interests and needs of the recreational community in unincorporated Clark County as it relates to planning, maintaining, and protecting recreation in the Colorado River area.
