In the nineteen seventies, I was elected to represent the membership of the International Union of Painters and Allied Trades, Local 391, Boston, MA to the position of Business Manager and Financial Secretary. Three years later I was reelected by a "white ballot", to serve another three years without opposition. During those first years, I re-organized how business was conducted between the Union and Management. We selected arbitration and negotiation with the Employer Association. Many times the Union and the Employer Association failed to agree and the parties opted to resolve their dispute through the American Arbitration Association, AAA. In many instances it was The Federal Mediation & Conciliation Service, FMCS. As the Business Manager, it was my responsibility to prepare and present the Union's case to the Arbitrator.




