**Summary:**

On April 30, 2025, Request for Qualification (RFQ) No. 607432-24 was advertised on the Clark County Purchasing website and in the Las Vegas Review Journal. Submittals were requested to expand broadband infrastructure and internet services on an as-needed basis.
