This Contract is for the construction of Legacy Trail Parking Lot and traffic signal improvements at the intersection of Charleston Boulevard and Sky Vista Drive in Clark County, Nevada. The work will generally consist of improvements including plantmix bituminous surface, curb and gutter, sidewalk, median, street lights, traffic signal, landscaping, utility adjustments, water and sewer laterals, pavement markings, signing, dynamic message sign, automated gate system, retaining wall, fencing, and guardrail.
