**BACKGROUND:**

Clark County was recently awarded \$440 million in Coronavirus State and Local Government Fiscal Recovery Funds (Fiscal Recovery Funds) under the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA). These funds provide a substantial infusion of resources to help turn the tide on the pandemic, address its economic fallout, and lay the foundation for a strong and equitable recovery.

Clark County has discretion to use the Fiscal Recovery Funds in the ways that best suit the needs of Clark County constituents- as long as such use fits into one (1) of the four (4) statutory categories as outlined in the Compliance and Reporting Guidance: State and Local Fiscal Recovery Funds Manual published by the United States Department of Treasury. The following are the four (4) statutory categories:

1. To respond to the COVID-19 public health emergency or its negative economic impacts;
2. To respond to workers performing essential work during the COVID-19 public health emergency by providing premium pay to such eligible workers of the recipient, or by providing grants to eligible employers that have eligible workers who performed essential work;
3. For the provision of government services, to the extent of the reduction in revenue of such recipient due to the COVID-19 public health emergency, relative to revenues collected in the most recent full fiscal year of the recipient prior to the emergency; and
4. To make necessary investments in water, sewer, or broadband infrastructure.

During July and August, Clark County engaged Management Partners to conduct various outreach efforts across Clark County to better understand the direct and immediate needs of the community as a result of the pandemic. These outreach efforts have included Clark County Commission meetings, neighborhood meetings, online surveys, grant pre-applications, and meetings with various public and private stakeholders.

At the August 3, 2021, Clark County Commission meeting, staff received a report from Management Partners about the outreach efforts, as well as initial allocation options of the Fiscal Recovery Funds to include in the County's Recovery Plan Performance Report to the United States Department of Treasury on August 31, 2021.
