BACKGROUND:

On July 19, 2016, the Board of County Commissioners approved a professional engineering services contract with GCW, Inc. for roadway improvements and rehabilitation of one or more existing public roadways within the County, as identified within the latest Capital Improvement Program adopted by the Board.

The Board previously approved seven supplemental contracts with GCW, Inc. to extend the contract term, and for additional engineering services.

Supplemental No. 8 to the professional engineering services contract with GCW, Inc. increases total funds for additional design and related services for work order projects. The time of performance remains effective until December 31, 2026, unless further time extensions are granted.

GCW, Inc. currently holds a Clark County Business License.

The District Attorney's Office has reviewed and approved the eighth supplemental contract as to form.
