The payment for VINE Program is in addition to the Monthly Fee amount for each year of the CONTRACT. First VINE payment would be payable in February of each year that the CONTRACT will be in effect.

Revenues paid to COUNTY shall not have been offset by any taxes, fees or license charges that may be levied, assessed or charged by any governmental entity or PROVIDER or COUNTY.

PROVIDER shall pay Customer a fixed monthly fee of \$125,000 per month during the term of the Agreement. This fixed monthly payment and, if applicable, any other payments owed under the Agreement other than the 12.5% percentage-based commission described above will be funded by revenue generated from PROVIDER'S products and services but will not be funded by telephone service revenue generated from Customer's facility(s).

For international call traffic only, the per-minute amount paid by the provider as a passthrough to its underlying wholesale international carriers to terminate international calls will not be commissionable. PROVIDER will charge international calling rates equal to or less than the FCC ordered International Rate Cap.

2. The revisions contained herein are effective as of October 26, 2021.

This Amendment No. 3 represents a decrease of \$750,000.

Except as expressly amended herein, the terms and conditions of the CONTRACT shall remain in full force and effect.
