Additional Comments:	The initial Contract amount was \$814,401.69, Amendment No. 1 increased the Agreement amount by \$775,000, Amendment No. 2 will have no fiscal impact. The new total Agreement amount will be \$1,589,401.69.		

BACKGROUND:

On April 19, 2018, the Board of County Commissioners (Board) approved the award of CBE No. 604790-18 for Geographic Information Systems (GIS) Software and Services to Environmental Systems Research Institute, Inc. (LBE) in the amount of \$119,430.14 and included further expenditures based upon department's approved budget, as funds were allocated.

The following are the pertinent provisions of the Agreement:

- The term of the Agreement was from date of award through five (5) years.
- Included the County's option to terminate for cause, convenience or default and suspend the Contract with advanced written notice.

Amendment No. 1 extended the Agreement for an additional five (5) one-year periods of GIS Products and Support.

Approval of Amendment No. 2 will provide an updated Maintenance and Support Program and include a Data Processing Addendum. The attached Amendment No. 2 document details the modifications involved.
