## **BACKGROUND:**

The Regional Transportation Commission of Southern Nevada (RTC) has approved the Grand Canyon Drive Bus Turnout and Pedestrian Flasher at Rochelle Avenue project on its annual Capital Improvement Program from its Highway Improvement Acquisition Fund - Fuel Revenue Indexing for Fiscal Year 2025.

Interlocal Contract No. 3216 provides funds for construction of the subject project. The work to be performed under this contract consists of constructing a bus turnout along Grand Canyon Drive and installation of a pedestrian flashing beacon at Rochelle Avenue. The work shall also include removal of curb and gutter, removal and replacement of sidewalk, removal of streetlight, removal and replacement of pavement markings, traffic signs, and other related items of work required to make a good, complete, and serviceable project. The design for the project was funded by Regional Transportation Commission of Southern Nevada Project 239F. The design is at least 90 percent complete, all necessary right-of-way to construct the project has been obtained, and Clark County is ready to advertise the project for construction. The time of performance is effective until June 30, 2030, unless time extensions are granted.

RTC has prepared Interlocal Contract No. 3216 for the Board's consideration. RTC approved the interlocal contract at its meeting on May 22, 2025.

The District Attorney's Office has reviewed and approved the interlocal contract as to form.
