

**SUPPLEMENTAL NO. 1 TO THE
PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERING SERVICES CONTRACT FOR
HOLLYWOOD BOULEVARD FROM
LAKE MEAD BOULEVARD TO CHEYENNE AVENUE**

THIS SUPPLEMENTAL NO. 1 CONTRACT, made and entered into this 1st day of February, 2022, between CLARK COUNTY, NEVADA, a political subdivision of the State of Nevada, hereinafter referred to as COUNTY, and KIMLEY-HORN AND ASSOCIATES, INC., a corporation authorized to do business under the laws of the State of Nevada, hereinafter referred to as ENGINEER.

WITNESSETH

WHEREAS, on June 2, 2020, the COUNTY and the ENGINEER entered into a Professional Engineering Services Contract to design roadway improvements on Hollywood Boulevard from Lake Mead Boulevard to Cheyenne Avenue; and,

WHEREAS, engineering services and a time extension to the contract are needed to provide alternatives for the roadway cross sections in various portions of the Project, and to provide additional storm drain facilities within Hollywood Boulevard to tie into the existing storm drain facility within Carey Avenue; and

WHEREAS, this Supplemental No. 1 contract increases funding by \$40,780.00 for special services revising the total contract amount to \$531,450.00, and extending the time of completion from June 30, 2022 to January 30, 2024.

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the premises and mutual covenants herein contained, the parties mutually agree to supplement the Professional Engineering Services Contract dated June 2, 2020, as follows:

ARTICLE I: DEFINITIONS

Revise the following definition:

“Project” means the roadway improvements on Hollywood Boulevard from Lake Mead Boulevard to Cheyenne Avenue. Such improvements are to include, at a minimum, visual pavement evaluation and hot mix asphaltic concrete pavement providing one (1) travel lane in each direction with a dedicated right turn lane at intersections, with raised medians, pavement overlay, bicycle lanes, storm drainage facilities as needed, curbs, gutters, sidewalks, ADA pedestrian ramp upgrades, LED streetlighting upgrades, traffic signal modifications (including installation of loop detectors), ITS facility installation, utility modifications and relocations, traffic control devices, pavement markings, intersecting streets, horizontal and vertical transitions, and other necessary appurtenances required to make a serviceable Project within a 100-foot right-of-way, except where additional lanes may be required.

ARTICLE II: SCOPE OF SERVICES

2.03 Special Services

Replace 2.03A as follows:

- A. Provide additional design and related services in the event the Director finds it necessary to perform additional work not specified in Section 2.02, but required for and related to the Project.

Additional design work consists of the following:

Evaluate and design a parallel storm drain facility within Carey Avenue between Hollywood Boulevard and approximately Monterey Pine Drive. Tasks include, but are not limited to, providing the necessary drainage study, utility and record drawings research, hydrologic and hydraulic analyses, five (5) potholes, update for the Project's drainage study, plan and profile, details, cost estimate and special provisions such that the parallel storm drain facility is incorporated into the contract documents for the Project.

Provide alternatives for the configuration of Hollywood Boulevard, including bike lane and breakdown lane options, median width options, potential removal of encroachments, increasing the sidewalk width along the schools to 10 feet, transitioning the pavement width to allow for the existing roadside channel and drainage culvert to remain, and providing associated roadway striping options.

ARTICLE IV: TIME OF PERFORMANCE

4.01 Time of Performance

Revise the last paragraph of this section to read as follows:

Except as set forth above, the ENGINEER shall complete all Basic Services and authorized Special Services within completion times as set forth above and by the end of **January 30, 2024** unless the Board of County Commissioners amends such date in writing.

ARTICLE V: PAYMENT FOR SERVICES

Revise the first paragraph of 5.01 to read as follows:

5.01 Maximum Amount Payable

The maximum amount payable by the COUNTY to the ENGINEER shall be a sum of money equal to the Basic Service fees plus the Special Service fees, if, as, and when approved by the Director, and provided, however, that under no circumstances may the total amount payable to the ENGINEER under this Contract or in connection with the

subject matter of this Contract, exceed the sum of Four Hundred Twenty-Eight Thousand, Nine Hundred Ninety-Five and 00/100 Dollars (\$428,995.00) for the Basic Service fees, and One Hundred Two Thousand, Four Hundred Fifty-Five and 00/100 Dollars (\$102,455.00) for Special Services fees, unless such sum is increased by the Clark County Board of Commissioners, but only to the extent such total sum is increased.

Revise the last paragraph in 5.02 to read as follows:

5.02 Basic Services and Special Services Fees

In no event may the fees exceed the following Basic Services and the Special Services fees shown below in purposes or amounts:

The remainder of the professional services Contract dated June 2, 2020, remains unchanged.
