Please see attached email & invoices from Hearing Officer Tobler who expended a total of 13 hours on the Hearing, totaling \$910.00 in compensation sought. Ms. Tobler states in Invoice B that *"The services provided were **justified and necessary** in this matter. Prior to the Hearing commencing, there were emails regarding requests to continue the hearing, and multiple emails from counsels for the Appellant and CCDFS, and then oral argument, regarding whether CCDFS needed to provide additional documents and witness subpoenas for the hearing as requested by Appellant. There were also emails, and oral argument right before the Hearing commenced, regarding Appellant's request to allow the Declaration of a private investigator produced the day of the Hearing as an Exhibit. The Decision was 8 pages long in order to address two separate allegations regarding two children"*
