

1. Original Proposal: Increase the SEPTAGE & CHEMICAL TOILET WASTE DISPOSAL FEE from 6 to 9 cents per gallon.

Recommendation: Staff recommends an increase to the Septage & Chemical Toilet Waste Disposal fee in accordance with this phased schedule- \$0.07/ gallon effective July 1, 2025; \$0.08/ gallon effective July 1, 2026; and \$0.09/ gallon effective July 1, 2027.

2. Original Proposal: Increase the annual FOGG INTERCEPTOR INSPECTION FEE from \$100 to \$125 for the inspection of a FOGG interceptor on a single parcel, and from \$50 to \$75 for the inspection of any additional FOGG interceptors on the same parcel.

Recommendation: Staff recommends an increase from \$100 to \$110 effective July 1, 2025, and an increase of \$110 to \$125 effective July 1, 2026; and for multiple devices on the same parcel, an increase from \$50 to \$60 effective July 1, 2025, and an increase of \$60 to \$75 effective July 1, 2026.

3. Original Proposal: Change the regulation to allow the use of HYDRO MECHANICAL FOGG INTERCEPTOR under certain limited conditions.

Recommendation: Same.

4. Adopt a \$1,000 HYDRO MECHANICAL FOGG INTERCEPTOR APPLICATION FEE to address the approval process of such an alternate device.

Recommendation: Same.

5. Original Proposal: Increase the CAPACITY MAINTENANCE CHARGE from 30% to 80%.

Recommendation: Staff recommends an increase from 30% to 50% effective July 1, 2025, and an increase from 50% to 75% effective July 1, 2027.

6. Original Proposal: Adopt a \$175 fee to process POINT OF CONNECTION requests.

Recommendation: Same.

7. Original Proposal: Adopt a PLAN REVIEW FEE of \$8.40 per foot of sewer pipe.

Recommendation: Staff recommends a rate of \$3.50 per foot of pipe effective July 1, 2025, and a rate of \$5.50 per foot of pipe effective July 1, 2026.

8. Original Proposal: Adopt a CONSTRUCTION INSPECTION FEE of \$6.50 per foot of sewer pipe.

Recommendation: Staff recommends a rate of \$3.50 per foot of pipe effective July 1, 2025, and a rate of \$5.50 per foot of pipe effective July 1, 2026.

9. Original Proposal: Change the regulation to require a POINT OF CONNECTION for single family residences.

Recommendation: Same.
