

## RESOLUTION

### SALE OF SURPLUS PROPERTY

**WHEREAS**, NRS Chapter 334.030, authorizes governmental entities to enter contracts for the sale of surplus property in order for governmental entities to take full advantage of the available surplus properties of another governmental agency; and

**WHEREAS**, the County of Clark owns a 2014 FORD F350 Extended Cab 4x4 Animal Truck, VIN #1FT8X3BT1EEA98165, (hereinafter referred to as the "Vehicle") that has exceeded the established criteria and is therefore retired from service within the Department of Administrative Services; and

**WHEREAS**, the Mineral County Sheriff's Office has expressed an interest in obtaining the vehicle to be used to assist with animal control efforts and is willing to sign the Contract of Sale Agreement.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Board of County Commissioners hereby declares the Vehicle to be surplus property, authorizes the sale of the above-described property to the Mineral County Sheriff's Office, subject to execution of the attached Contract of Sale Agreement.
