 PLAN AMENDMENT to redesignate the existing land use category from Corridor Mixed-Use
 (CM) to Entertainment Mixed-Use (EM) on 9.0 acres. Generally located on the north side of Moapa Valley Boulevard, 350 feet west of Whitmore Street (alignment) within Moapa Valley. (MK/gc) (For possible action)
- ZC-23-0357-SCHLAF WILLIAM M 1986 TRUST & SCHLAF WILLIAM M TRS: ZONE CHANGE to reclassify 9.0 acres from an R-U (Rural Open Land) Zone, R-E (Rural Estates Residential) Zone, C-1 (Local Business) Zone, and C-2 (General Commercial) Zone to an R-V-P (Recreational Vehicle Park) Zone.
