

## AMENDMENT NO. 1 CBE NO. 606117-22 BETTERMENT COMMUNITY

THIS AMENDMENT is made and entered into this day of 2025, by and between CLARK COUNTY, NEVADA (hereinafter referred to as "COUNTY"), and UNITED STATES VETERANS INITIATIVE (hereinafter referred to as "PROVIDER").
WITNESSETH:
WHEREAS the parties entered into an agreement under CBE Number 606117-22, entitled 'BETterment Community' dated June 14, 2022 (hereinafter referred to as CONTRACT); and
WHEREAS the parties desire to amend the CONTRACT.
NOW, THEREFORE, the parties agree to amend the CONTRACT as follows:

2. Section II: Compensation and Terms of Payment, Page 1

COUNTY agrees to pay PROVIDER for the performance of services described in the Scope of Work (Exhibit A) for the not-to-exceed amount of \$3,367,960. COUNTY'S obligation to pay PROVIDER cannot exceed the not-to-exceed amount. It is expressly understood that the entire work defined in Exhibit A must be completed by PROVIDER and it shall be PROVIDER'S responsibility to ensure that hours and tasks are properly budgeted, so the entire PROGRAM is completed for the said fee.

- Participation in treatment, religious services or other services and activities;
- History of criminal justice involvement;
- Employment/income;
- · Payment or ability to pay.
