Recommendation:

Consider and approve the Business Impact Statement, pursuant to NRS Chapter 237, for the proposed amendments to Clark County Code Title 9, Chapter 9.04, to revise and add certain definitions; provide for commercial rates for certain residences from which a business is conducted; provide for overflow charges in certain circumstances; provide for bulky item collection at multifamily complexes; updates the rates and charges to current amounts; requires mandatory subscription to solid waste collections services for all premises; changes the annual rate increases based on the Consumer Price Index to an index rate based on water, sewer and trash collection services; clarifies and enhances certain customer service and repair standards; clarifies certain telephone answering standards; allows franchisee to withhold solid waste collection services to commercial and industrial customers in certain circumstances; and providing for other matters properly related thereto; and set a public hearing. BACKGROUND:

Pursuant to NRS 237.080, before adopting a proposed rule, the Board must consider a business impact statement to determine whether the proposed rule will: (a) impose a direct and significant economic burden upon a business; or (b) directly restrict the formation, operation or expansion of a business.

Pursuant to NRS 237.090, a business impact statement must be considered by the Board at a public meeting held at least 10 calendar days before the public meeting of the Board held to adopt the proposed rule.

The attached business impact statement summarizes the comments received from the business community and individuals and addresses the impact of the proposed ordinance on potentially affected businesses.

Staff recommends that the Board consider and approve the attached business impact statement.
