Recommendation: AG-26-900195: Discuss whether to initiate a Master Plan Amendment to the Clark County Trails Map within the Clark County Master Plan, and direct staff accordingly. (For possible action)

FISCAL IMPACT:

BACKGROUND:

Commissioner Jones requests the Board of County Commissioners (Board) discuss whether to initiate a Master Plan Amendment to amend the Clark County Trails Map within the Clark County Master Plan (Trails Map). Trails shown on the Trails Map must be dedicated and meet specific requirements of the Clark County Unified Development Code (Title 30) and the Clark County “Development Standards for Off-Street Trails” whenever land is subdivided or developed.

More specifically, Commissioner Jones requests the Board discuss the potential addition of a new trail alignment along South Hualapai Way from Blue Diamond Road south to Gomer Road. This proposed alignment would help close existing gaps between the Mountains Edge Parkway Trail and the LaBaron Paseo Trail, located east of Hualapai Way. This proposed alignment would also support future connectivity associated with the Vegas Valley Rim Trail.

Further, staff requests the Board provide direction on any other potential changes to the Trails Map as well as direct staff to incorporate updates, such as trail development status, additions/deletions/adjustments to trail alignments, and to make other corrections as needed.

Staff requests the Board discuss and direct staff accordingly.
