CLARK COUNTY COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG)

3rd SUBSTANTIAL AMENDMENT TO THE 2020-2024 CONSOLIDATED PLAN AND THE 2022-2023 HUD ANNUAL ACTION PLAN

Clark County proposes to reallocate the sum of \$3,234,238.00 from unobligated/de-obligated CDBG funds to the Bridge Counseling Associates Inc. Adult Transitional Housing and Youth Residential Treatment Center which is an approved project in the FY2020-2024 Capital Improvement Plan. This will bring their total allocation to \$7,476,257.

The additional allocation is deemed crucial to cover the funding shortfall primarily caused by significantly higher costs of building materials. This will ensure that the project is completed based on the design and ensure that the subrecipient can deliver the much-needed services to the community.

Consistent with the Citizens' Participation Plan, these proposals are now being submitted for public comments. Comments should be sent in writing to CRMInfo@ClarkCountyNV.Gov or mailed to 1600 Pinto Lane, Las Vegas, NV 89106 and will be accepted until 5:30PM of June 24, 2024.

Once approved, the 2020-2024 Consolidated Plan and 2022-2023 Annual Action Plan will be amended to reflect this allocation and submitted to HUD.
