Approve and authorize the Chair to sign Supplemental No. 1 to the interlocal contract between Clark County and Regional Flood Control District to increase total funds for design, and change the name of the project from Tropicana Avenue Conveyance between Las Vegas Wash and Andover Drive to Tropicana Avenue Conveyance between Duck Creek Wash and Andover Drive. (For possible action)

Additional Comments:	Initial contract amount was \$1,670,000. Supplemental No. 1 increase of \$620,000 revises the total contract value to \$2,290,000.		

BACKGROUND:

On August 10, 2023, the Clark County Regional Flood Control District (RFC) entered into an interlocal contract with Clark County to provide funding for design, right-of-way, entity design labor, environmental, and Conditional Letter of Map Revision/Letter of Map Revision (CLOMR/LOMR) for the Tropicana Avenue Conveyance between Las Vegas Wash and Andover Drive project. The Board of County Commissioners approved the interlocal contract on September 5, 2023.

Supplemental No. 1 to the interlocal contract increases design funds to address wetlands coordination and CLOMR/LOMR, as well as changes the name of the project from "Tropicana Avenue Conveyance - Las Vegas Wash to Andover Drive" to "Tropicana Avenue Conveyance - Duck Creek Wash to Andover Drive". The time of performance remains effective until June 30, 2028, unless time extensions are granted.

RFC approved the first supplemental contract at its meeting on January 8, 2026.

The District Attorney's Office has reviewed and approved the first supplemental contract as to form.
