<u>USE PERMITS</u> for public utility structures including the following: 1) battery energy storage system (BESS) electrical substation with associated equipment; and 2) 230 kV overhead transmission line.

WAIVERS OF DEVELOPMENT STANDARDS for the following: 1) landscaping; and 2) off-site improvements (curbs, gutters, sidewalks, streetlights, and paving).

Mr. Sullivan stated they have not optimized the plan yet and are still working on it. Also, that someone had spoken to our MVFD, and they will be working with Chief Neel regarding fire suppression, and safety. They will not be disposing of dead batteries on site. It was agreed that this area will benefit from these as to some voltage support. Blake Stratton disclosed that he worked for NV Energy but did not feel conflicted about voting.
