FIRST AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT FOR ALLOCATION AND USE OF MT. CHARLESTON LICENSE PLATE PROGRAM FUNDS

This Amendment to the Agreement for Allocation and Use of Mt. Charleston License Plate Program Funds is made and entered into this 18th day of January, 2022 by and between Las Vegas Metropolitan Police Department ("LVMPD"), and the County of Clark, a political subdivision of the State of Nevada ("County"), and collectively ("Party or Parties").

RECITALS

Whereas, on or about July 6, 2021 LVMPD and County entered into an Agreement to provide funding pursuant to the authority granted by NRS 482.37935, for the purchase of an enclosed Off-Highway Vehicle (OHV) trailer; and

Whereas, the County through its Department of Administrative Services, accepted solicited bids from LVMPD for the acquisition of an OHV trailer; and

Whereas, current supply chain issues have resulted in increased costs that exceed the amount awarded under the Mt. Charleston License Plate Program by four thousand and forty-five dollars (\$4,045.00); and

Whereas, the County has sufficient funds in the Mt. Charleston License Plate Program to pay the additional cost of the trailer;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the premises and terms contained herein, the parties agree as follows:

AMENDMENT

- Exhibit A, Section 1(a) to the Agreement shall be amended to read;
 (a) Twelve Thousand Three Hundred sixty-eight dollars (\$12,368.00) to purchase an OHV trailer.
- 2. All other provisions of the Agreement shall remain the same.
